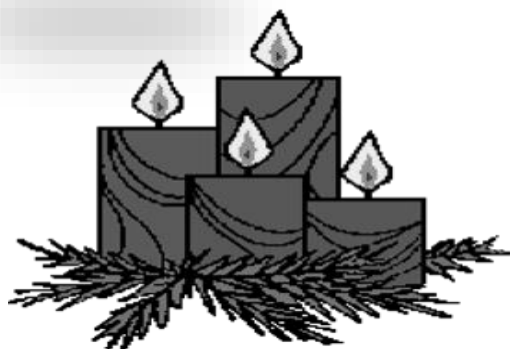

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every week-day at 5:00p.m. also Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church and at 8:30a.m. and 10:30 a.m. on Sundays or by appointment by calling the business office 631-273-8113.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Marriage: Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

Holy Orders: Is God calling you? Call a Priest or Deacon to discern a possible vocation to the Priesthood, Diaconate or the Religious life.

4TH SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

It is amazing how simple yet wonderful is God's plan to come to live among us and to save us. The plan set right at the garden of Eden, prepared by announcements of the Prophets, comes to realization thousands of years later in most human yet miraculous way. "The Voice in the desert " calling all to prepare the way for the Lord. John the Baptist was the immediate "sign" before Jesus manifested himself to the people of God. Jesus birth was preceded with the Annunciation to the "Full of Grace" Blessed Virgin Mary. Then in today's Gospel we hear that Saint Joseph had his Annunciation by the Angel of the Lord, so that he would be able to overcome his fears and provide the necessary support to Mary and Jesus by providing them home and security. Without Joseph and his commitment to his family it would be impossible for Jesus to have a normal home. It was through Joseph's faith that it was possible.

Is this an indication why the lack of faith makes it impossible for normal families to live without trauma of breakdown, since it requires the faith of both spouses and both parents to make it possible to survive the difficulties of life, and that is true even for the Holy Family ? Who was the angel that talked Joseph into going with the plan? Do you believe in Angels? Do you listen for their advise? How hard is it to meet an Angel? How often we meet or hear the Angels ? Joseph's experience of prayer, of a dream, his encounter with the divine gives him strength to face all the challenges of life and helps Jesus to live a normal life and accomplish his mission of saving us. Thank you St. Joseph for doing what you did. No wonder why Pope Francis wanted St Joseph to be remembered in all Masses.

What is amazing is that God continues to come into our lives, and he continues to send us the angels and saints to awaken us to god's plan. The Blessed Mother continues to speak to us. So this is why we have so many feasts and titles for her, which commemorate those events and give us the message from God. This is why we need to come to Mass, because those experiences of heavenly things will give us the strength to live our lives and walk with God through our lives.

On the December 8th we celebrated "the fullness of grace " of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Immaculate Conception, that was defined in that term in dogma of Immaculate Conception in the year 1854, and confirmed by the apparitions of the Virgin Mary to St. Bernadette in Lourdes in 1858. This past December 12 we celebrated the feast of the Blessed Mother of Guadalupe that we moved to this Saturday so that all could attend, it is to commemorate her apparitions to a Native American Juan Diego. She came to him, so that through him she could speak to all of us. Did you ever pay attention to that apparition ? Did you ever read what she had to say? Do you even care to know what she has to say? Or do you prefer to be indifferent because you think that she is a Mexican and now from the other side of "the wall"? Do you think that she should come to you personally for you to believe it and even to care about it? Don't look strange as you see that beautiful decoration and flowers in our church thinking that it is for the other people because you are not Mexican ? She came again for you and me, who live in the Americas, who live in this planet, in this world. Please go on the website: sancta.org and read the history of apparitions where it accounts in red print all what Blessed Mother said to Juan Diego and to you and me. Do you believe this? Will you give time to it to find out what she says or will you act as if it never even happened ? Next time we meet I will ask you if you did read it, if you care to know and give her a chance to speak to you.

She said to Juan Diego :

'Know and understand well, you the most humble of my son, that I am the ever virgin Holy Mary, Mother of the True God for whom we live, of the Creator of all things, Lord of heaven and the earth. I wish that a temple be erected here quickly, so I may therein exhibit and give all my love, compassion, help and protection, because I am your merciful mother, to you, and to all the inhabitants on this land and all the rest who love me, invoke and confide in me; listen there to their lamentations, and remedy all their miseries of afflictions and sorrows. And to accomplish what my clemency pretends, go to the palace of the bishop of Mexico, and you will say to him that I manifest my great desire, that here on this plain a temple be built to me; you will accurately relate all you have seen and admired, and what you have heard. Be assured that I will be most grateful and will reward you, because I will make you happy and worthy of recompense for the effort and fatigue in what you will obtain of what I have entrusted. Behold, you have heard my mandate, my humble son; go and put forth all your effort.'

This was some of her words to him and to us. She appeared 4 times to Juan Diego, than on the tilma, than to Juan Bernardino the uncle of Juan Diego. The account is just 7 pages long, a small extension of the Gospel, Mary speaking to all of us. Let's take it as fact of our lives and it will give us the strength and motivation to go with god's plan in our lives, as St. Joseph's encounter with an angel empowered his faith and helped him to understand and to love Mary and Jesus. Isn't it what we want ?

Remember- He is the reason for the season!!!!

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,
