From the Pastor- Fr. Stan

June 25, 2017

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

After the feast of Corpus Christi, that is of Body and Blood of Christ, this Friday we celebrated feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. From his Eucharistic presence under appearance of bread and wine, we come to recognize Jesus human heart not as physical organ, but as that place, which we define as place from which we love, as place where we perceive happiness, as place where we suffer hurts, a place that we see as the center of our person with all feelings and emotions.



Jesus is true God, but Jesus is true man as well, and as such he has all that every person has, except sin. Jesus feelings and emotions are in their full range, his heart is corresponding to every other being. Our recognition of this reality helps us to relate to Jesus as to another perfectly corresponding person, that knows and perceives every human situation in divine and fully human way. We remember how it is reported by the Gospel, that John the Baptist rejoiced in the womb of his mother Elizabeth at meeting with Jesus in Mary's womb. John the Baptist is the greatest man born of a woman ever, as Jesus told of him. John's faith and hope were unparalleled, as they culminated in his own life as the voice calling in the desert: prepare the way for the Lord. His faith was total and he did not hesitate to lay down his life for the truth. We want to take the example of John the Baptist in pursuing Christ and the truth of the Gospel in our lives. We want to imitate his total love and dedication to it. Over the ages, Jesus continues to reveal his heart to the Saints, and to all who seek him with a sincere heart. Let's take the promises of his love and make them our own, and that will make us happy and fulfilled, transformed and enlightened.

I hope you had a great Father's Day. I hope that you feel blessed, being gifted with the gift of life and all its potential. Make a difference by loving in return.

See the promises of Jesus Sacred Heart, as Jesus says in the Gospel of today: Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father.

Let us enjoy the summer, vacation, and family time.

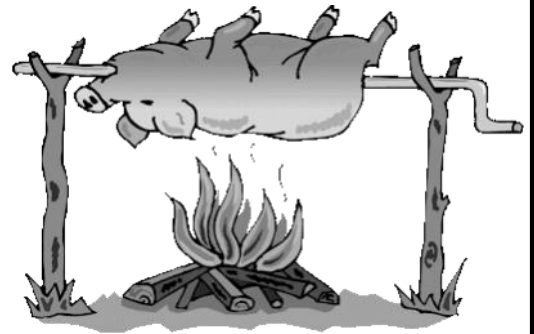

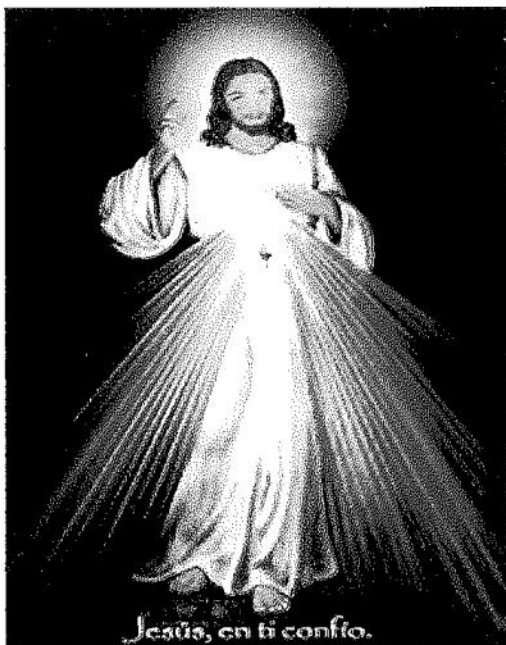
