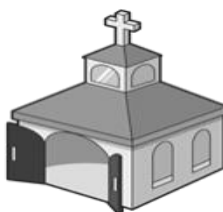

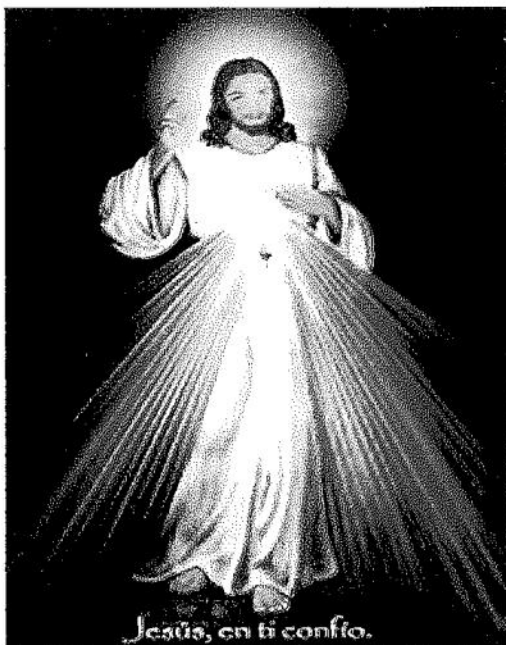

Etre bienheureux, pour Jésus, n'est pas avoir du pouvoir, de la richesse, ou de l'Age. Etre bienheureux c'est avoir de l'esprit positif, être gentille, compatissant et miséricordieux. L'évangile fourmille de gens privilégiés: les pauvres héritent le royaume au détriment des riches, les pêcheurs sont appelés et non les justes, les enfants et leurs pareils entrent dans le royaume et non les puissants, et ici les gens incultes reçoivent la révélation du mystère de Dieu qui reste cache aux sages et aux savants. Pourquoi ces gens qui ne possèdent rien de ce qui attire habituellement l'attachement ou l'estime: ni la richesse, ni la puissance, ni la culture religieuse, ni la perfection morale, sont-ils privilégiés de Dieu? "Père, tu l'a voulu ainsi dans ta bonté," nous répond Jésus. En portant sa tendresse sur ces êtres démunis Dieu révèle qu'il n'aime pas par convoitise, mais gratuitement, non pour les mérites de l'autre, mais pour le faire grandir et l'épanouir. Qui se veut le disciple de Jésus et prend le jour de son commandement d'amour entre dans la compréhension de ce mystère ou il trouve joie et soulagement. C'est pourquoi les affliges, les humiliés, les blessés de la vie trouvent en lui réconfort et repos.
