Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This weekend we will have Deacon Manuel J. Ramos talking to us at all the Masses about the missionary efforts of our Diocese, as to motivate all of us to take part in the mission of the Church: of proclaiming the Good News to the end of the earth.



We all want to share in the work of Jesus, because we all want to share in his glory. We share in it by actively reaching out to people by word and witness of life, or by supporting the mission efforts by material financial participation. So let's be part of the work, so we can be part of the festivities in heaven for eternal life after our death. Let the Word of God take good roots in our lives, and bear good fruits of good deeds for eternal life. Missions are fun, it's always fun to participate in other people's lives, it's fun to bring others to Christ. The purpose of our lives is to get to heaven, so let's be on our way toward it.

In the Gospel of today, Jesus explains to us the important thing about the existence of evil in the world. Isn't it part of our questions in life why things do happen ??? With today's parable, Jesus answers that question.

Evil came to the world not by making of the owner, but by the negligence of the servants. Evil can not have its origin in God. Its reason and origin is as well beyond man. " Death came into the world by the envy of the Devil, and is experienced by those who belong to him" Wisdom 2,24. Sowing of evil came with the fault of the people, because they were not vigilant. This lack of vigilance is used by the enemy who sabotages the work of the farmer. The enemy sows a lie in the heart of the man, that produces distrust, despair, egoism Genesis 3,1.... Evil comes in darkness and enters unnoticed. The seeds of good and evil grow parallel in the heart of the man, the truth and lie exist next to each other. Human efforts to eliminate external evil ends in hurting human person who is identified with the evil, and that is mistake because no man is totally evil, there is always some good in every human being. We cannot condemn the good of the person because of our hatred for evil.

Even in the Church we can't totally eliminate the evil by making it the church of the pure because it would be another distortion of truth, as the church of perfect people does not exist. The Church it is not a Sect of the pure and perfect, but it is association of sinners in need of God.

God invites us to patiently wait for the time of harvest, when his Angels will separate the good from the evil, and until than He allows the good and evil to coexist until the judgment day. By the design of God, the evil will serve to become the place of revelation of god's greatest good, that is God's Mercy. So what is needed and excepted of us is faith and acting upon it. As Scripture says : Love covers multitude of sins 1Peter 4:8. We are called to act with prudence choosing good and avoiding evil. On the end of times we will be judged by Divine Mercy and not by any human sense of justice. Only God knows what is in the heart of the man.





C'est aussi à la clémence et à la longanimité de Dieu que conclut le sage qui s'exprime dans notre première lecture. Le Seigneur maîtrise sa force et juge avec une sereine équité. Par là, il apprend à son peuple à être humain. En exaltant la patience de Dieu, les auteurs inspirent dénoncent simultanément nos excès de zèle et notre incorruptible propension à exclure et à condamner. Nos particularismes ne doivent pas devenir des barrières discriminatoires. Non sans humour, Jésus nous invite à assumer avec réalisme notre condition historique: tous ensemble, nous formons un champ extraordinairement mêlé.

La patience de Dieu envers les pécheurs que nous sommes n'est pas signe de faiblesse, mais de l'espérance qu'il met en nous.
