## From the Pastor- Fr. Stan

*Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ Jesus,*

*Easter it is a beautiful season, that reveals to us the fullness of life here on earth, and eternal life that is to come. So for us Christians, this life is just but preparing for eternal life. All that we do, should be preparing us for that transition, and for our new life with God and all those worthy of eternal life. It's going to be fun as it is here on earth, when we try to work for that purpose. It's fun but not necessarily easy, because life has a lot of challenges. As persons of faith we are challenging ourselves to see all events of our lives in the light of faith.*



*In today's Gospel, Jesus proves to be faithful to his promise of being with his disciples always until the end of times, and he does not wait for them to be calling on him, but he joins in with them, as they seem to be walking away from the place where they left him, where He apparently was taken away from them. He walks with them, listening to their reasons and complaints, their hopes and expectations. Jesus did not interrupt them until they confessed their unbelief, and then He explains all the Scriptures to them.*

*The disciples urged Jesus to stay with them, as they described later: their hearts were burning within, as Jesus was explaining Scriptures to them. And it was only in the breaking of the bread, that they recognized Him. Isn't it as significant as well for us, that Jesus becomes recognizable to them in the Eucharist ??? The place to meet and to see Jesus is the Eucharist. How many of us would want to see Jesus ??? So He tells us: don't be slow to believe, don't be foolish, but believe.*

*How beautiful is it, that this and next Sunday we have our First Communion for our children ??? Let their First Communion be for us an opportunity to open our eyes once more to the mystery of Christ's presence among us. Let it remind us of our own First Communion and how innocent we were then, and how Communion helped us over the years to be the Christians that we are today. How the Eucharist kept the faith of generations of Catholics, to hand this mystery and this gift to us ???*

*For this belief and for this faith, many Catholics gave up their lives over centuries and continue to do so today in different parts of the world. Let us believe firmly, and let us help those children and those young people to come to a closer friendship with Christ through the Eucharist and through Holy Communion.*

*Please bring your children to Christ. Bring them to Sunday Mass, because it is in that breaking of the bread, that it is easiest to recognize Jesus, it is possible to hear His explanation of the events of life, that otherwise have no explanation. It is Jesus that comes our way, to share his life and his love with us, even when we don't understand, or even when we are running away from him. He is with us always. Don't we wish that, for our children and for ourselves ???*

*Stay with us Lord for it is nearly evening and the day is almost over. Please make our hearts burn with love for You and for your words. Lord make yourself known to us in all events of life.*

*May Christ give you the experience of his healing power through Holy Communion, may He enlighten your path of life as he did for the disciples walking to Emmaus.  
God bless you always !!!!*

*Today I want to thank Bertha and all the teachers and volunteers helping us with Religious Education for the children and for the adults. It is a principle way of evangelization, by sharing the faith with those who want to know it, with those who long to receive Christ in the Eucharist. It is the breaking of the bread with someone who wants to encounter Christ. I thank you for all your sacrifices that you do in that regard. May the Lord reward all your efforts with his blessings and love for you and your whole family.*

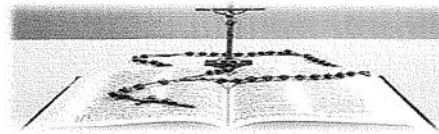

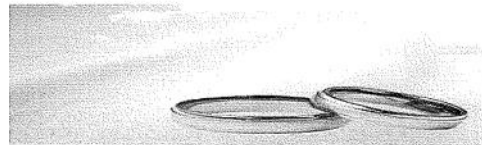
