From the Pastor- Fr. Stan

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Today is the 4th Sunday of Easter and is called a Sunday of Good Shepherd. Christ is the Good Shepherd that is leading his sheep into heaven. Resurrected Jesus lives in heaven and invites all of us, who want to hear his voice and follow him into the glory of heaven.

Meanwhile here on earth, He is present to us under the Sacramental appearance of Bread and Wine, and as it was in last week's Gospel, Jesus can be recognized in the breaking of the bread. In this time, we see Him particularly in the beauty of the First Communion reception by our children. It is a special moment for each person to be prepared and to receive Him who is our life and salvation. Holy Communion keeps us close to God. Keeps us united to the whole body of Christ, the Church. Holy Communion makes us a family of God. That Holy Communion made us brothers and sisters even if we come to St Anne's from all corners of the world. Holy Communion makes us holy and happy, it fills us with meaning in life and gives it direction. It brings God's Mercy and peace to our troubled hearts, it gives us rest. Holy Communion fills us with the presence of Jesus and helps us to become like Him, as we become what we eat, and nourished by Christ we aspire to be like Him. If we persevere in following Jesus our Good Shepherd, we will attain happiness of heaven.

Today I want to thank all our Deacons, Teachers and Volunteers, who help with our Religious Education/Faith Formation and with our children and youth. I thank Mrs. Bertha Keenan and all her staff for their hard work and dedication to Jesus' flock, especially to the little lambs of our community who are to receive First Communion and Confirmation, on May 20th. I want to thank all our parents for their cooperation, and I remind you to continue to bring your children to receive Holy Communion regularly every Sunday. We want them to be and to feel close to Jesus. Let's help them in it, as they can't do it without you.

With this coming Mothers Day, I wish all of our Mothers, to have great satisfaction from your children and their accomplishments in school and in life. Remember that they can do it only if they are close to God. Only God can protect and save them. If you want to see what Holy Communion can do, look at the - Eucharistic Miracles - on the internet and you will find plenty of accounts, what Jesus does and how He becomes miraculously present in the history of men of all times. On the left side to the altar you can see the statue of Our Lady of Fatima, to remind us of the 100th anniversary of Her appreciations in Fatima. As she appeared to three children than, she is surely concerned about the children today. The month of May is dedicated to Blessed Mother, to bring us closer to Her, who gave us Jesus and teaches us with her example and words: as She tells us to do, whatever Jesus is asking of us. Blessed Mother came to speak to three little shepherds, asking them for prayer and sacrifices, to show us how she cares about the little hearts of children who love her with great love. Let's bring our children to Blessed Mother by teaching them the prayer of the rosary. Praying the rosary is like holding the Blessed Mothers hand, and how much love she has for children, she showed by appearing to them. See for yourself the history of apparitions on the internet, how much care the Blessed Mother shows for everyone, for every human being, for the whole world.

We have in our Parish The Legion of Mary Prayer Group in English and Spanish who teach us how to be coworkers of Mary in bringing others to Jesus to be saved. Ask them how you may become a member of the soldiers of Mary, fighting for the Kingdom of Christ and his Mother .

This weekend please be sure to take home a copy of Bishop John Barres's Pastoral Letter -Miracle of the Sun Fatima 100 years! In it Bishop Barres ask everyone to pray the rosary once a day during this month of May dedicated to Mary. God bless everyone! Enjoy the beauty of spring, it's new life that God gives to every living thing, to every plant and flower, and through them to us.

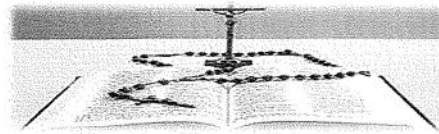

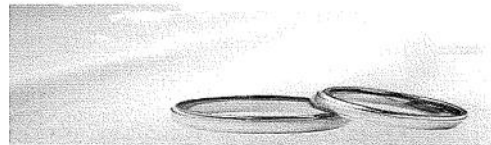
