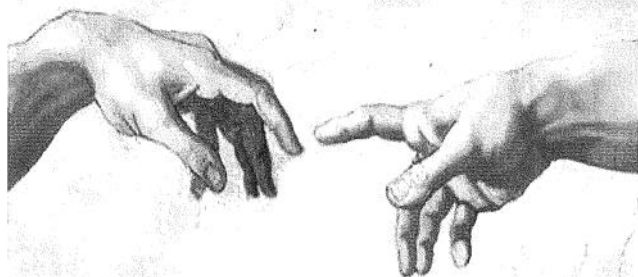

From your Pastor:



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Imagine, we have Palm Sunday coming next week and the following week is Easter. Isn't it fast, too fast for being able to enjoy the Lenten preparations and efforts to be transformed by the Lenten practices of extra prayer, fasting and alms giving ?

We had our Lenten Soup Supper this past Friday evening and I want to thank Deacon John our head chef and his wonderful volunteers for all their hard work in their preparation of a solidarity meal for the sake of alms giving and fraternal communion.

This Sunday after our evening 5:00 p.m. Mass we will have a presentation on *Women at The Cross*, preparing us to appreciate the role of women in the life of Christ and the Church, especially seeing it at the time of Christ Passion and Resurrection. Please plan on joining us for this Lenten presentation.

Today, this 5th Sunday of Lent we have the Gospel of Lazarus being allowed to die and than being raised from the dead back to life. And interestingly enough, Jesus calls Lazarus dying: "being asleep", and Jesus promises to awaken him. Is Jesus mocking the death? Is he comparing the death to a sleep? Is it a parable? Jesus often explains things by making that kind of comparisons and references. If Jesus compares death to being asleep it must be comparable. Do you believe this? It would be nice for us if we all would have the possibility of waking up in heaven as Jesus suggests it. He makes it sound very easy and simple. Already prophet Ezekiel in the first reading foretells the rising from the graves and putting back the human spirit into the bones bringing them back to life. It would be nice if Jesus could do it more often - for example if he could rise up those young people killed in Brentwood by gangs, and give them back to their families - to be able to have a "normal" life and a "normal" ending to it one day.

The Scriptures make this process of rising seem to be so simple and obvious, so natural. Jesus says to the dead friend: "Lazarus come out !!!" Even Lazarus sister Martha says- "*it is already four days after death and its already going to be stench*", but Jesus responded to her: "**Did I not tell you that if you believe you will see the glory of God?**"

As Lazarus comes out of the grave, Jesus tells others to untie him so he can walk freely. So last Sunday we had Jesus making us see the glory of God, by returning the sight to a blind man from the birth, and today we see the glory of God by seeing Jesus put back the spirit into the dead body of his friend Lazarus. Would Jesus do it for everyone? Or just to his friends?

Saint Paul says to us in second reading: "*If the Spirit of God dwells in you, the One who raised Christ from the dead will give life to your mortal bodies also.*" What a certainty, what a sequence of things said about dying and rising? And next Sunday we will read the Passion of Christ and take a walk with the Palm in our hands to follow Christ as he is to take his cross and walk from life to death and back to life again on the Easter Sunday. It is a display of the power and the glory of God, that is promised to those who believe and turn their hearts and lives to Christ. That is the purpose and goal of Lent and of life.

God bless everyone !!!!

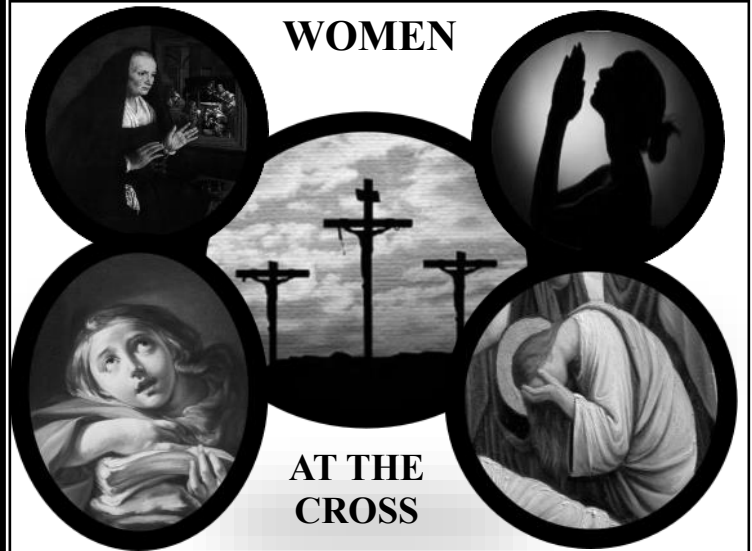

Kerigma*

Una breve reflexión acerca de la Cuaresma antes que esta termine.

Iniciamos la última semana de Cuaresma, el domingo próximo será “de Ramos y Palmas”. Estos cinco domingos en los Evangelios hemos recibido una “profunda instrucción bautismal”, y por supuesto una llamada a la conversión personal y comunitaria.

I domingo, Jesús y las Tentaciones: del pan, de la historia y de los ídolos del mundo

II domingo, la Transfiguración del Señor: la cruz camino para llegar a la Vida

III domingo, Jesús dialoga con la Samaritana: tenía sed de la fe de aquella mujer

IV domingo, Jesús da la vista a un Ciego: para que se manifieste en éste, la gloria de Dios

Hoy, **V Domingo**, Jesús obra una “presunta resurrección” en Lázaro (Jn 11, 1-45). Y puede obrar en nosotros “un verdadero milagro”, que despertemos del letargo y del desinterés y “escuchemos que nos llama”, a lo mejor “llevamos ya más de cuatro días en el sepulcro” (v. 39b), al margen de la voluntad de Dios en nuestra vida, “como uno que tiene nombre de vivo, pero está muerto” (Ap 3,1).

La Cuaresma es preparación para vivir el “núcleo del misterio de la fe” (CIC 638-658): pasión, muerte-sepultura y Resurrección del Señor, seríamos ingenuos si nos quedamos en el Viernes Santo, dolidos y sin esperanzas, o si viviéramos la liturgia como algo lindo o meramente folklórico y tradicional, y se nos olvidara que Jesús realmente vive, que hizo propias las consecuencias del Pecado del hombre, murió y resucitó... la experiencia de Lázaro fue solo una emulación de lo que el Padre obraría en Él (v. 43), pero su Resurrección es la certeza de la vida inmortal que será una realidad para nosotros (Ap 22).

Sin embargo, la resurrección no es “solo algo de ultratumba”, es un acontecimiento que vivimos aquí y ahora, somos “la Iglesia de la Pascua” que hace presente los valores del Reino, por eso en cada Eucaristía luego de ser instruidos con la Palabra y alimentados con el Cuerpo-Sangre de Cristo somos enviados como mensajeros de buenas noticias (Christifideles Laici, 2).

Continuemos con las prácticas cuaresmales del ayuno, la oración y la caridad; el próximo domingo acompañemos a Jesús que entrará triunfante en Jerusalén.

*Llamaré lo que publique en el Boletín semanal: *Kerigma*, espero que realmente, sea una Buena Noticia para quienes lo reciban, “dichos los pies del mensajero que anuncia buenas nuevas” (cf. Is 57,7; Rm 10,15).

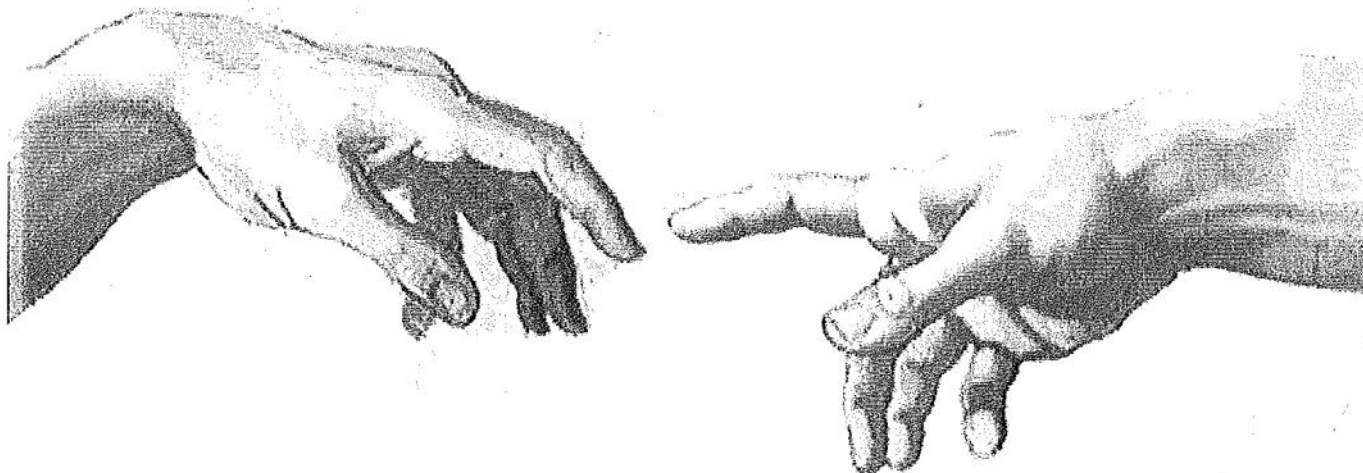

Je suis la résurrection et la vie

Dans l'Evangile de ce Dimanche, le rappel de Lazare a la vie tient en quelques lignes et l'intérêt se porte sur les dialogues qui précèdent et veulent préparer le lecteur a faire acte de foi en Jésus vainqueur de la mort. Tandis que les disciples acceptent de suivre Jésus jusqu'a "mourir avec lui" s'il le faut, Marthe confesse en Jésus le Fils de Dieu, le Maître de la vie des maintenant et pour toujours. Les Juifs, trompes par ses larmes et son émotion devant la mort, mettent des bornes au pouvoir de Jésus qui peut bien, selon eux, guérir un aveugle ou Lazare malade, mais doit s'avérer impuissant devant la mort. Pourtant eux aussi, a la vue du miracle, croient en lui. D'autre part, ce miracle place juste avant la passion de Jésus préfigure sa mort et sa résurrection. En effet, si lazare sort les mains et les pieds lies de bandelettes et le visage enveloppe d'un suaire, ce qui rappelle symboliquement qu'il reste encore mortel, Jésus sortira a Pâques immortel, délivré a jamais de la mort. en Jésus, la vie aura triomphe. "Seigneur, donne-nous le gout et l'audace de suivre Jésus, ton Fils, jusque dans sa passion afin que ton printemps d'amour nous fasse renaître a la vie."
