FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Looks like winter is gone and spring is approaching, although we know that still cold weather will come on and off, but slowly our senses awaken to the reality of longer daylight and brighter sunshine. So it is with the seasons in the Church, that after Christmas season and few weeks of Ordinary Time, with Ash Wednesday we started the season of Lent.

Lent it is a time of preparation for the Easter. It is a time of awakening from the coldness of winter to the warmth and beauty of coming spring. It is a time of awakening from the coldness of our hearts to the reality of Christ's heart burning with love for us.

In order to correspond to Christ's love, one needs to be humble and realistic about the need to be saved. That need for wholeness, for healing, for love can be satisfied only by God. Our human brokenness is beyond just human repair, it needs a Divine intervention, it needs God's touch. The fulfillment of our happiness and love is found in Christ, who comes down to us and lays down his life for us, so that we can be saved from our brokenness of sin, from the coldness of our hearts.

Without Christ, our sins would pile up and make a burden too heavy to carry, and it would bring about our own condemnation and destruction. Christ takes away our burdens and makes our hearts whole again, capable of merciful love for God, for ourselves and for others.

That is the purpose of Lent; to resubmit our lives to Christ again in humble surrender, looking to find ways in which we would be more and more free from selfishness of sin, free from brokenness and hurts, that we accumulate along the path of life.

Isn't it a high goal to consider ourselves to be the ambassadors of Christ, as St Paul called us to be in the 2nd letter to Corinthians that we read on Ash Wednesday ??? That is the goal, that you and I should arrive at; to be so transformed as to become similar to Christ, as to resemble Him to others. That is the purpose of Lent. To resent it, is to resent Christ's invitation to friendship, to ignore it, is to ignore Christ, to turn away from it, is to turn away from God. To take it seriously, is to take seriously life, ourselves and God. Resenting life, resenting love, resenting friendship of God would be totally against the purpose of our lives. We need to welcome life, we need to become friends with God, we need to fall in love with God, with others and with ourselves. That is the fullness of life, that Christ wants to bring to our life. The way of becoming those ambassadors of Christ, leads through reconciliation with Christ, with others and with ourselves.

Jesus' lesson about prayer, penance and almsgiving is a sure way of acquiring what we are looking for. It is in the secret of one's heart, that all that process happens. Joy of life, love and peace are the treasure of one's heart. If you already found them, you have arrived at where the Lord wants you to be, so continue to flourish.

But if you don't feel like you arrived yet, then keep walking the path laid down by Christ himself, and you shall find. The Lord will not delay in coming your way seeing your honest search for him. By prayer we search for God, by penance we search our own heart, by almsgiving we search for others. Let's be on our way to explore this invitation by our Lord this Lent, so that we may experience the fullness of life that Christ offers us in Easter.

Please take the bulletin, to find out on weekly basis what the Parish offers us to be part of in our Lenten journey this year. Remember the weekly Way of the Cross, at 6:00pm on Friday in English, 6:30pm Thursday in Spanish, and 7:00pm on Friday in Creole.

For Sacramental Penance we have opportunity every day at 5:00pm, and for Almsgiving we can always increase our collection gift to the parish and to Outreach program.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church or by appointment.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Marriage: Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

Holy Orders: Is God calling you? Call a Priest or Deacon to discern a possible vocation to the Priesthood, Diaconate or the Religious life.

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament: Each Thursday from 12:30 PM until 5:15 PM. First Friday from 5:30 PM until 7:00 PM. Rosary after the 12:00 daily Mass.

CUARESMA TIEMPO DE CONVERSION

- Ayuno y Abstinencia-

La Cuaresma este año está comprendida entre Febrero 14 y Marzo 29. Maliciosamente, este año, Miércoles de Ceniza fue “St. Valentine's day” y es probable que para muchos haya sido “casi imposible el Ayuno y la Abstinencia” de cualquier tipo que estos fueron “nuestros excesos”, no hay que preocuparnos, todos los Viernes de Cuaresma son días para la Abstinencia. De Febrero 14 hay que aclarar, la Iglesia celebra la memoria de los SS. Cirilo y Metodio patronos de la Evangelización en Europa y ejemplo de “amor fraterno”. Las prácticas de estos días (ayuno, oración y caridad), no son nada nuevo ni exclusivo de este este Tiempo cuaresmal pero vale enfatizar en ellos pues la intención es prepararnos para vivir los días Santos de la Pasión, Muerte y Resurrección del Señor.

La Iglesia encuentra el sentido de la Cuaresma en la Escritura misma, solo por citar algunos personajes bíblicos: Moisés (Ex 34:28), Elías (1 Re 19:8) y el mismo Jesús (Mt 4:1)...así paso a ser “practica espiritual para el mundo cristiano” y en particular para la Iglesia Católica. Las cosas adquieren sentido cuando se las damos, un detalle muy pequeño dado con cariño Febrero 14 lo tiene por su origen (amor, amistad, etc.), lo mismo el Ayuno y la Abstinencia no son prácticas 'per se', tienen como objetivo hacernos experimentar “la Muerte” y llevar a contemplar “la Vida” en Cristo Resucitado.

Y aunque los Domingos serán de Cuaresma estos días, también es el Dia del Señor por lo mismo, a mi entender hoy “no se ayuna”, todo lo contrario, puede ser un buen motivo para ir de visita donde alguna persona que hace tiempo nos espera, ancianos o enfermos, familiares o amigos, más importante que ayuno y abstinencia, la oración y la caridad deben primar el Domingo.
