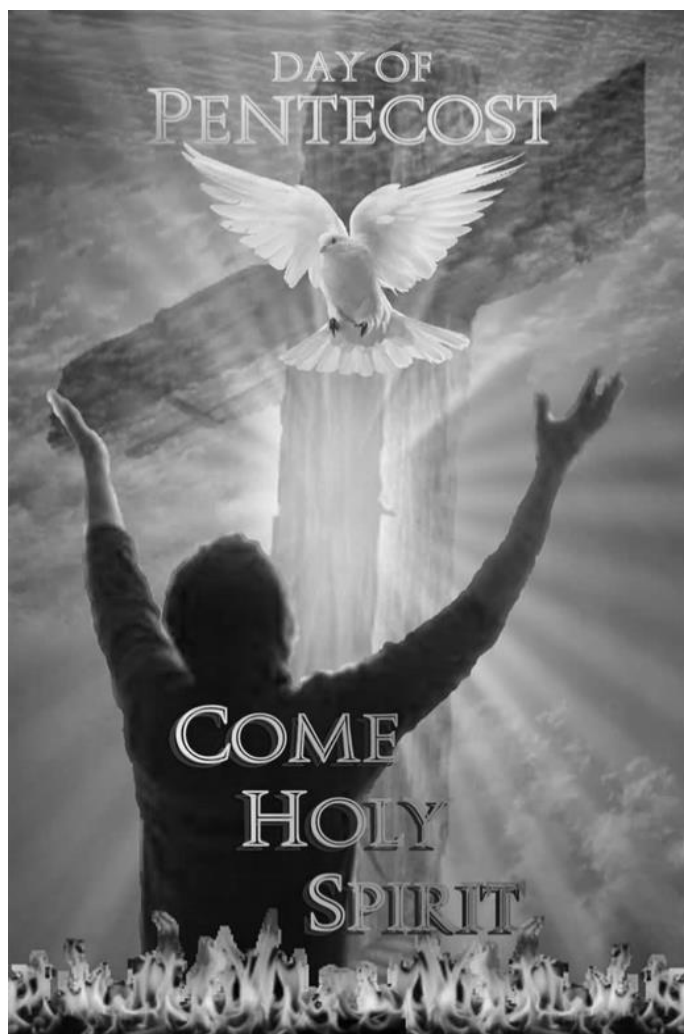

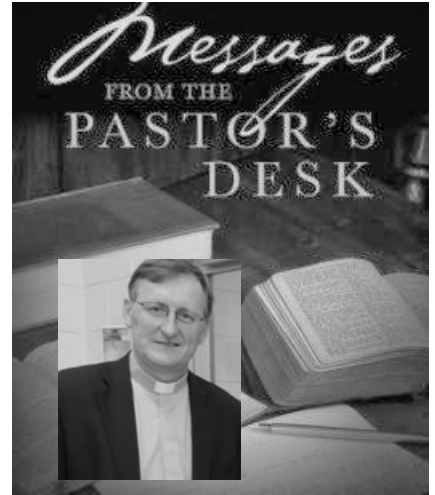

PENTECOST SUNDAY



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

With all the blessings of the Easter Season we are arriving at the culmination of it with the celebration of Pentecost. Easter was about Jesus saving work done for all and every person who ever lived and who will ever live in the world. Pentecost is about Holy Spirit empowering the Apostles and followers of Christ to continue Jesus' saving work, by taking the Good News to the ends of the world. Jesus gives the responsibility for spreading of the Gospel to his disciples. Now, empowered from within their hearts, they are not afraid anymore to stand for Christ. It took them 50 days to grieve for what had happened to Jesus at the cross, and how they abandoned him for the fear of the Jews. It took them all this time to forgive themselves for abandoning and betraying Jesus on Good Friday. Jesus did not hold a grudge against the Apostles after his Resurrection, rather he was offering his peace to all. Now with the grace of Pentecost the disciples become the new persons, renewed in their faith and humanity, capable of giving their lives for friendship with Christ. Jesus did his part in saving us, now it's our turn to collaborate with him for our salvation and salvation of all.

Pentecost is about the abundance of God's grace and gifts for those who want to serve. We want to ask for those gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit as St. Thomas Aquinas comments on them:

- 1 - **Wisdom** is both the knowledge of and judgment about "divine things" and the ability to judge and direct human affairs according to divine truth.*
- 2 - **Understanding** is penetrating insight into the very heart of things, especially those higher truths that are necessary for our eternal salvation—in effect, the ability to "see" God.*
- 3 - **Counsel** allows a man to be directed by God in matters necessary for his salvation.*
- 4 - **Fortitude** denotes a firmness of mind in doing good and in avoiding evil, particularly when it is difficult or dangerous to do so, and the confidence to overcome all obstacles, even deadly ones, by virtue of the assurance of everlasting life.*
- 5 - **Knowledge** is the ability to judge correctly about matters of faith and right action, so as to never wander from the straight path of justice.*
- 6 - **Piety** is, principally, revering God with filial affection, paying worship and duty to God, paying due duty to all men on account of their relationship to God, and honoring the saints and not contradicting Scripture. The Latin word pietas denotes the reverence that we give to our father and to our country; since God is the Father of all, the worship of God is also called piety.*
- 7 - **Fear of God** is, in this context, "filial" or chaste fear whereby we revere God and avoid separating ourselves from him—as opposed to "servile" fear, whereby we fear punishment.*

These gifts, according to Aquinas, are "habits," "instincts," or "dispositions" provided by God as supernatural helps man in the process of his "perfection." They enable man to transcend the limitations of human reason and human nature and participate in the very life of God, as Christ promised (John 14:23). Aquinas insisted that they are necessary for man's salvation, which he cannot achieve on his own. They serve to "perfect" the four cardinal or moral virtues (prudence, justice, fortitude, and temperance) and the three theological virtues (faith, hope, and charity). The virtue of charity is the key that unlocks the potential power of the seven gifts, which can (and will) lie dormant in the soul after baptism unless so acted upon.

Because "grace builds upon nature", the seven gifts work synergistically with the seven virtues and also with the twelve fruits of the Spirit and the eight beatitudes. The emergence of the gifts is fostered by the practice of the virtues, which in turn are perfected by the exercise of the gifts. The proper exercise of the gifts, in turn, produce the fruits of the Spirit in the life of the Christian: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, modesty, self-control, and chastity (Gal. 5:22–23). The goal of this cooperation among virtues, gifts, and fruits is the attainment of the eight-fold state of beatitude described by Christ in the Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5:3–10)."

There is plenty for us to pray about as the abundance of God's love is infinite. All best wishes for all our adults and youth that will receive the Confirmation this week. May all those gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit manifest themselves in them and in all of us in the Parish and in our whole Church.

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos,

Con todas las bendiciones de la temporada de Pascua, estamos llegando a la culminación con la celebración de Pentecostés. La Pascua fue sobre Jesús salvando el trabajo realizado para todos y cada persona que alguna vez vivió y que alguna vez vivirá en el mundo.

Pentecostés es un Espíritu Santo que otorga poder a los Apóstoles y sigue a Cristo para continuar la obra salvadora de Jesús, llevando la Buena Nueva a los confines del mundo.

Jesús da la responsabilidad de difundir el Evangelio a sus discípulos. Ahora, facultados desde dentro de sus corazones, ya no tienen miedo de defender a Cristo. Les tomo 50 días lamentarse por lo que le había sucedido a Jesús en la cruz y como lo abandonaron por el temor de los judíos. Les tomo todo este tiempo perdonarse a sí mismos por abandonar y traicionar a Jesús el Viernes Santo. Jesús no guardo rencor contra los apóstoles después de su resurrección, sino que estaba ofreciendo su paz a todos. Ahora, con la gracia de Pentecostés, los discípulos se convierten en nuevas personas, renovadas en su fe y humanidad, capaces de entregar sus vidas por la amistad con Cristo. Jesús hizo su parte para salvarnos, ahora es nuestro turno de colaborar con el para nuestra salvación y salvación para todos.

Pentecostés es acerca de la abundancia de la gracia y el don de Dios para aquellos que quieren servir. Queremos pedir esos dones y frutos del Espíritu Santo como los comenta Santo Tomás de Aquinas sobre ellos:

“1- Sabiduría es tanto el conocimiento como el juicio sobre las” “cosas divinas” y la capacidad de juzgar y dirigir los asuntos humanos de acuerdo con la verdad divina.

2- Comprender es penetrar en la comprensión del corazón mismo de la cosa, especialmente en aquellas verdades superiores que son necesarias para nuestra salvación eterna, la capacidad de “ver” a Dios.

3- El consejo permite que un hombre sea directamente por Dios en los asuntos necesarios para su salvación.

4- La fortaleza denota firmeza mental para hacer el bien y evitar el mal, especialmente cuando es difícil o peligroso hacerlo, y la confianza para superar todos los obstáculos, incluso los mortales, en virtud de la seguridad de la vida eterna.

5- El conocimiento es la capacidad de juzgar correctamente sobre asuntos de fe y acción correcta, para no desviarse nunca del camino recto de la justicia.

6- La piedad es, principalmente, venerar a Dios con afecto filial, rendirle culto y deber a Dios, pagar el deber debido a todos los hombres a causa de su Relación con Dios, y honrar a los santos y no contradecir las Escrituras. La palabra latina pietas denota la reverencia que le damos a nuestros padre y a nuestro país; Puesto que Dios es el Padre de todos, la adoración de Dios también es piedad.

7- El temor a Dios es, en este contexto, miedo “filial” o castigo por el cual reverenciamos a Dios y evitamos separarnos de él, en lugar de miedo “servil”, por el cual tememos el castigo.

Estos dones, según Aquinas, son “hábitos”, “instintos” o “disposiciones” proporcionados por Dios como ayudas sobrenaturales al hombre en el proceso de su “perfección”. Permiten al hombre trascender las limitaciones de la razón humana y la naturaleza humana y participar en la vida misma de Dios, como lo prometió Cristo (Juan 14:23).

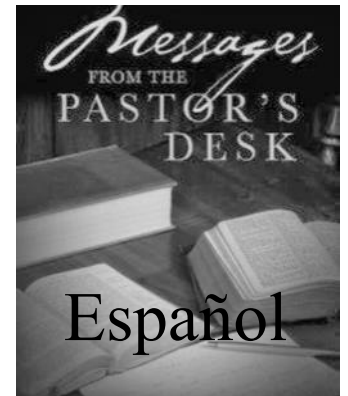
Aquinas insistió en que son necesarios para la salvación de hombre, que no puede lograr por sí mismo. Sirven para “perfeccionar” las cuatro virtudes cardinales o morales (prudencia, justicia, fortaleza y templanza) y las tres virtudes teológicas (fe, esperanza y caridad). La virtud de la caridad es la clave que desbloquea el poder potencial de los siete dones, que pueden (y estarán) dormidos en el alma después del bautismo, a menos que se actúe sobre ellos.

Debido a que “la gracia se basa en la naturaleza”, los siete dones trabajan en sinergia con las siete virtudes y también con los doce frutos del Espíritu y las ocho bienaventuranzas. La aparición de los dones es fermentada por la práctica de las virtudes, que a su vez se perfeccionan por el ejercicio de los dones. El ejercicio correcto de los dones, a su vez, produce los frutos del Espíritu en la vida del cristiano: amor, gozo, paz, paciencia, bondad, generosidad, fidelidad, gentileza, modestia, autocontrol y castidad (Gálatas 5:23-23). La meta de esta cooperación entre virtudes, dones y frutos es el logro del octavo estado de beatitud descrito por Cristo en el Sermón del Monte (mat.5:3-10).


Hay mucho por lo que podemos orar ya que la abundancia del amor de Dios es infinita. Los mejores deseos para todos nuestros adultos y jóvenes que recibirán la Confirmación esta semana. Que todos esos dones y frutos del Espíritu Santo se manifiesten en ellos y en todos nosotros en la parroquia y en toda la iglesia.

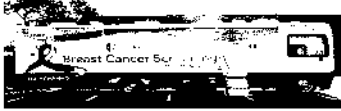
