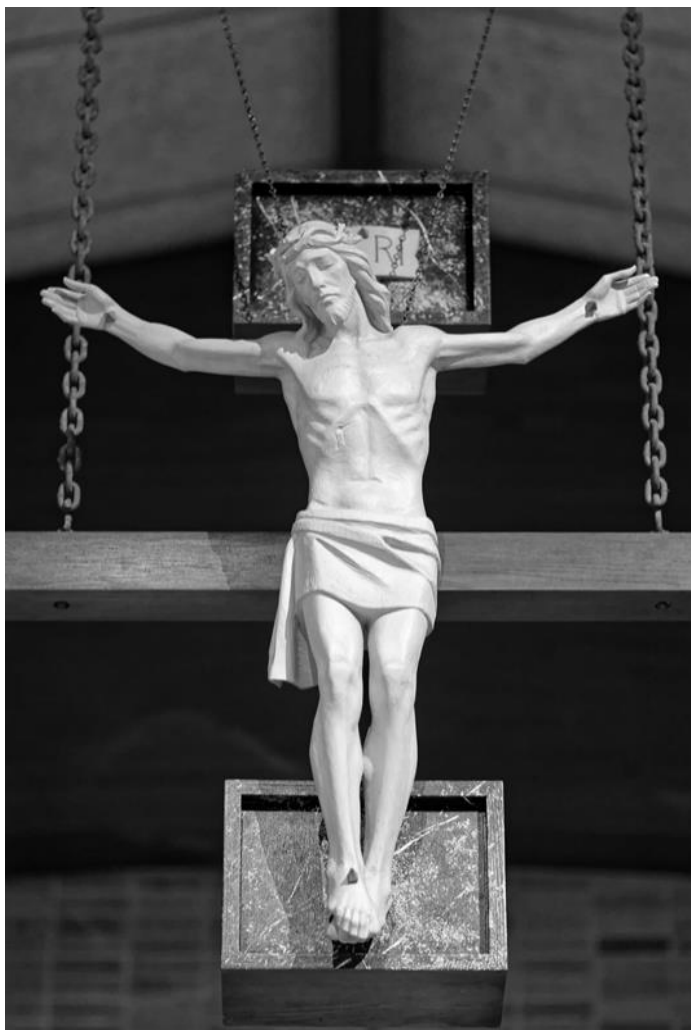

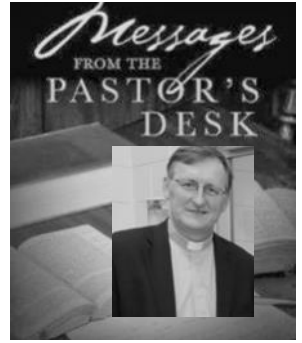

25th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Praise the Lord who lifts up the poor!

When we speak about poverty, we may understand deprivation of something needed, therefore causing oneself to worry and many times to face suffering. When we see a poor person, provably the immediate thought is: "I wish I would never have to live through that myself!" The face of poverty is not created by God! Poverty has come into being by mankind as consequence of Original sin.

The First reading of the Prophet Amos who lived more than 25 centuries ago, is about the issue of injustice towards the most vulnerable in society: "When will the new moon be over, that we may sell our grain, and the Sabbath, that we may display the wheat? We will diminish the ephah, and add to the shekel and fix our scales for cheating!" I remember when I was as a Missionary in Tanzania, we had a very bad drought and many of the crops failed. The people who had stored little from the previous year were selling their corn for a very cheap price because that was what the buyers offer, and they could not do otherwise. Then the very people who bought from them resold it to them when they needed food to eat, but for a much higher price, making very exuberant profits; so the rich were getting richer and the poor, poorer.

Does this sound familiar? Is this activity still happening in our own time? Poverty is not the will of God but of mankind, this is why the Psalmist defends the poor as does Amos the Prophet. And we should do as well! We ourselves know from our own experience, that the poor do not always have the same chance as others of experiencing true justice, and we know that the powerful who wish to oppress them can find the means to cover their exploitation with a legal cloak.

But God is the Pride, the Honor of the people, the Defender of the voiceless, the weak and the poor. He takes their part. He will not forget the evils done by the powerful and rich. He will have the last word, the Supreme Judge who gives justice. The prophet as does our Lord Jesus more than a threat, calls to CONVERSION. Richness needs to be redefined if we are Christians and Catholics, otherwise we may fall short of its true meaning. Jesus our Lord sets in the Gospel the parable of the Canniness of the shrewd steward, lover of money and cheater of his master's goods. Money- the word is capitalized, as if it were a personified idol- can only deceive: it is false and dishonest; the one who relies on it goes quickly astray. After all, it must be abandoned someday, for no one among the dead finds wealth of any more use.

What is the only way to use it profitably and be assured of a future in the eternal Life? Sharing it with those who need it to live, giving it to those who beg. Then the poor whom we helped, whom will become our friends, thanks to our almsgiving will be there to welcome us into heaven. Choose you Master then: God or Money, because no one can serve two masters. He will either hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. Jesus in the Gospel certainly do rebuke dishonesty in the manipulation of money as in everything else but it also teaches us that there is only one prudent way of making use of it: sharing it with the poor, for no one is truly the master of what she or he owns. Hoarding money is inadmissible and leads to the loss of the only Good whose possession is promised us: The eternal Inheritance. ***Fr. Cirilo Cervantes.***

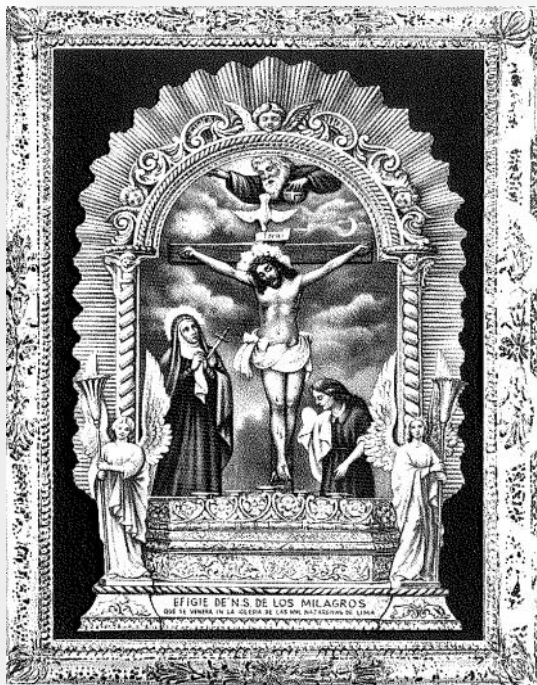
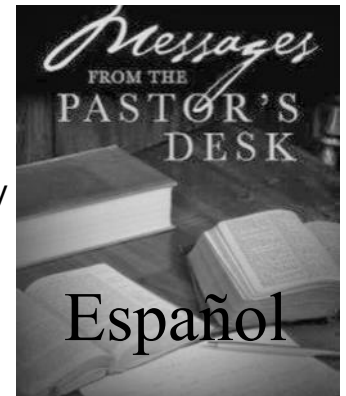
