Message from Our Pastor

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This weekend we celebrate a double feast of our earthly celebration of Father's Day and a heavenly celebration of Corpus Christi, that is of the Body and Blood of Christ who became the bread for our salvation. Both of the celebrations have great implications for our lives, as each of us has a father, and each of us is saved by Christ. These two mysteries permeate our lives for the whole of its extent. We may be conscious of it in our daily lives, or forgetful in the businesses of life that we create around ourselves, but even if we would forget those realities, they will continue to affect every day of our existence now and in eternity, because they refer to persons on whom our existence totally depends. Our father on earth and Christ in heaven, will never stop loving us. What more could we ask for? What more could anyone give us?

In this, lies the secret of this weekend, and we are invited to ponder these mysteries, and they should inspire our awe and contemplation, then action, or rather relationship. Our God is a God of living not of the dead. This is why, we should be the best of the person that we can be, if we are mature enough to keep those relationships going. If our parents are alive, let's be attentive to them. If they died, let's pray for them, let's offer Mass intentions for them, that is the most that we can give to someone, the gift of God himself. Those relationships will always affect our lives, and they will enrich us and make us persons of love. Let us stay engaged, and they will transform us into the saints, as it was the intent of God himself at the creation.

Corpus Christi is a reminder to us of this living mystery of Christ's presence in the life of the world. When we get to heaven, we will then understand how Jesus' presence in us and in our world was impacting our life, and how it nourishes us for eternal life. As our blood runs through our veins and brings nourishment to all cells of the body, so the blood of Jesus nourishes our soul, with nourishment of eternity. "Lord give us this food always", the disciples said when Jesus talked to them about the bread of eternal life.

I don't know if you ever read about the Eucharistic Miracles, when the host is changed into the real body, the real human tissue. There are many of those events in the history of the church on the extent of the ages. There are even some people, that ate only Eucharist and lived for years on this heavenly diet. Is it possible to live just on the little Host? Humanly, it's impossible, but by the grace of God, yes. It is the cooperation of faith with God's grace. It's a miracle of love and of life that God bestowed on some, so that we might believe in what Jesus is giving us. To foster our faith, the church invites us to make Corpus Christi processions. We will have had our procession after 7:00pm Mass this Saturday. We have as well our weekly adoration on every Thursday afternoon. We have some extra adoration for First Fridays also.

This Sunday for Corpus Christi, I proposed to the priests to make the moment of adoration on the end of Masses with the benediction with the Blessed Sacrament, to raise our awareness of the Real Presence of Jesus in it. It can be done by skipping the homily and making it as meditation in front of the Blessed Sacrament, so the Mass doesn't get longer and we get the occasion to make some more personal connection with the Eucharistic presence of Jesus. Can I live on the Host alone? - no, can you live on the Host alone? - probably not, but we certainly can be more devoted and reverent towards Jesus in the Eucharist, present always at Mass and later in the Tabernacle.

One of the great Saints devoted to the Eucharist was St Joseph of Cupertino. Read on his incredible life experiences. The origins of the Corpus Christi processions go back to Eucharistic miracles as well, and was first established in Universal Church in 1264 by Pope Urban IV. Let's open ourselves to the knowledge and experience of those realities and they will greatly affect and transform our lives.

Happy Father's Day to all!!! Happy Corpus Christi feast!!!

SOLEMNIDAD DEL SANTISIMO CUERPO Y SANGRE DE CRISTO (CORPUS CHRISTI)

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos,

Este fin de semana celebramos una doble fiesta de nuestra celebración terrenal del Día del Padre y una celebración celestial de Corpus Christi, es decir del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo que se hizo pan para nuestra salvación. Ambas celebraciones tienen grandes implicaciones para nuestras vidas, ya que cada uno de nosotros tiene un padre, y cada uno de nosotros es salvado por Cristo. Estos dos misterios impregnan nuestras vidas en toda su extensión. Podemos ser conscientes de ello en nuestra vida diaria, u olvidadizos en los negocios de la vida que creamos a nuestro alrededor, pero incluso si nos olvidamos de esas realidades, seguirán afectando todos los días de nuestra existencia ahora y en la eternidad, porque ellos se refieren a personas de las que depende totalmente nuestra existencia. Nuestro padre en la tierra y Cristo en el cielo, no dejan de amarnos. ¿Qué más podemos pedir? ¿Qué más nos puede dar alguien?

En esto radica el secreto de este fin de semana, y estamos invitados a reflexionar sobre estos misterios, y deben inspirarnos asombro y contemplación, más que acción, o más bien relación. Nuestro Dios es un Dios de vivos nos de muertos. Por eso, debemos ser lo mejor de la persona que podemos ser, si somos lo suficientemente maduros para mantener esas relaciones. Si nuestros padres están vivos, estemos atentos a ellos. Si han fallecido, oremos por ellos, ofrezcamos intenciones de Misa por ellos, eso es lo más que podemos dar a alguien, el don del mismo Dios. Esas relaciones marcarán siempre nuestra vida, nos enriquecerán y nos harán personas de amor. Mantengámonos comprometidos, y ellos nos transformaran en santos, como fue la intención del mismo Dios en la creación.

Corpus Christi nos recuerda este misterio vivo de la presencia de Cristo en la vida del mundo. Cuando lleguemos al cielo, comprenderemos como la presencia de Jesús en nosotros y en nuestro mundo estaba impactando nuestra vida y como nos nutre para la vida eterna. Así como nuestra sangre corre por nuestras venas y nutre todas las células del cuerpo, así la sangre de Jesús nutre nuestra alma, con alimento de eternidad. “Señor, danos siempre este alimento”, decían los discípulos cuando Jesús les hablaba del pan de vida eterna.

No sé si alguna vez leyeron sobre los Milagros Eucarísticos, cuando la hostia se transforma en el cuerpo real, el tejido humano real, Hay muchos de esos eventos en la historia de la iglesia a lo largo de los siglos. Incluso hay algunas personas que solo comieron la Eucaristía y vivieron durante años con esta dieta celestial. ¿Es posible vivir solo de la pequeña Hostia? Humanamente es imposible, pero por la gracia de Dios, sí. Es la cooperación de la fe con la gracia de Dios. Es un milagro de amor y de vida que Dios concedió a algunos, para que creyéramos en lo que Jesús nos está dando. Para fomentar nuestra fe, la iglesia nos invita a realizar las procesiones de Corpus Christi. Tendremos nuestra procesión después de la misa de las 7:00pm este sábado. También tenemos nuestra adoración semanal todos los jueves por la tarde. También tenemos un poco de adoración adicional para los primeros viernes.

Este Domingo de Corpus Christi, propuse a los sacerdotes hacer el momento de adoración al final de las Misas con la bendición con el Santísimo Sacramento, para hacernos conscientes de la Presencia Real de Jesús en ella. Se puede hacer omitir la homilía haciéndola como una meditación frente al Santísimo Sacramento, para que la Misa no se alargue y tengamos la ocasión de hacer una conexión más personal con la presencia eucarística de Jesús. ¿Puedo vivir solamente de la Hostia? – no, ¿puedes vivir solo con la Hostia? – probablemente no, pero ciertamente podemos ser más devotos y reverentes hacia Jesús en la Eucaristía, presente siempre en la Misa y luego en el Sagrario.

Uno de los grandes Santos devoto de la Eucaristía fue San José de Cupertino. Lea sobre su increíble experiencia de vida. Los orígenes de las procesiones de Corpus Christi también se remontan a los milagros Eucarísticos, y se establecieron por primera vez en la Iglesia Universal en 1264 por el Papa Urbano IV. Abrámonos al conocimiento y la experiencia de esas realidades y ellas afectaran y transformaran grandemente nuestras vidas.

« Donnez-leur vous-mêmes à manger »



Aujourd'hui pour le cœur d'un chrétien, c'est le plus grand jour, car l'Eglise, après avoir fêté le Jeudi Saint l'institution de l'Eucharistie, veut à présent exalter cet auguste Sacrement, en nous incitant tous à l'adorer sans limites. «Quantum potes, tantum aude...», «ose tout ce que tu peux»: ainsi nous invite saint Thomas d'Aquin dans un merveilleux hymne de louanges à l'Eucharistie. Cette invitation résume admirablement quels doivent être les sentiments de notre cœur devant la présence réelle de Jésus-Christ dans l'Eucharistie. Tout ce que nous pouvons faire est peu de choses pour correspondre à un don de soi si humble, si caché, si impressionnant. Le Créateur des cieus et de la terre se cache sous les espèces sacramentelles et s'offre à nous comme aliment de nos âmes. C'est le pain des anges et la nourriture de ceux qui sont en chemin. Pain qui nous est donné en abondance, comme nous fut distribué sans mesure le pain miraculeusement multiplié par Jésus, afin d'éviter le dépérissement de ceux qui le suivaient : « Tous mangèrent à leur faim, et l'on ramassa les morceaux qui restaient : cela remplit douze paniers » (Lc 9,17).

Si l'Évangile nous dit d'abord qui est Jésus, il parle également de l'Église, c'est-à-dire de chacun de nous, une Église appelée à donner à manger à tous les affamés. Mais comment le faire si nous ne prenons pas le temps de nous laisser nourrir nous-mêmes par la Parole et par le Pain, si nous n'avons pas l'expérience de cette intimité avec Jésus qui nous accompagne sur les chemins de la vie ? Proclamer la mort de Jésus ressuscité, c'est s'engager dans un chemin où il y a les pas de Jésus. C'est vivre de son Esprit. C'est devenir à notre tour un pain partagé pour les autres qui ont faim. Et cela, dit Paul, jusqu'à ce qu'il vienne. Bien que nous connaissions maintenant l'Église en tant qu'institution mondiale comprenant des membres de toutes les situations géographiques et sociales imaginables, nous avons tendance à ne pas considérer cette diversité mondiale comme un facteur de notre communion. Certaines personnes meurent de faim alors que d'autres sont trop nourries. Est-ce que les sévères avertissements de Paul sur les dangers de manger le pain ou de boire la coupe d'une manière indigne (dans les versets 11 : 27-32 qui suivent la lecture) pourraient aussi nous avertir des dangers de vivre nos rites, sans faire en sorte que les programmes de lutte contre la faim dans le monde soient au cœur de la vie de notre Église ?

Nous avons nous aussi à rompre le pain, à le partager. C'est même une priorité dont les chrétiens devraient se souvenir. La faim ne commence qu'avec quelqu'un qui prétend avoir la nourriture pour lui seul. Ne serait-ce pas une des significations de la multiplication des pains ? Quand des hommes et des femmes partagent le pain et le vin au nom de Jésus ressuscité, ils ne sont plus seuls. Jésus se rend présent au milieu d'eux. D'une présence si forte qu'il n'y a pas de meilleur mot pour le dire que celui de « présence réelle » de Jésus ressuscité. Le fait de tous venir à la table, sans distinction de classe sociale ou autre, est un acte révolutionnaire. L'Église est appelée à cette proclamation jusqu'à ce que Dieu revienne.

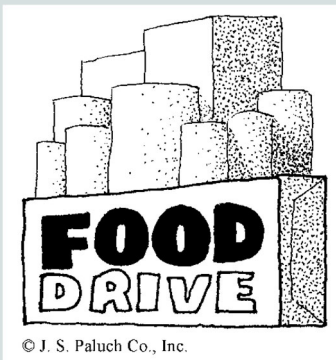
