Dear Sisters and Brothers,

As September is getting closer to us and children are preparing for school to begin, we are aware that the summer is coming to an end. We have much to be grateful for in the months of summer as we were blessed with wonderful time with friends and family. We are happy to know that Our Lord is never on vacation and always sustaining us in every moment of our existence, providing us with what we need and what is best for us. We are in constant Communion of life with God even when we lose our consciousness of it. To be aware of this total dependence, would take us where the readings of this Sunday want to take us, towards the humility in all things of life.

Our pride comes from our self-preservation instinct, but true humility comes from the communion with God and giving him glory, admiration and gratitude. The humble person is blessed with the realism of judgment, always knowing their place before God and in relation to others, and this is why they are pleasant to be around, since they don't infringe on the ego of those around them. Rather they humbly take the last place, as it helps them to be closer to God who humbled himself in Christ to take on our human condition.

In the Gospel as Jesus tells the parable of those invited for the feast, and he himself is the one that actually puts into practice what he teaches. All his interaction with others shows his humble dealings and patient teaching, again not in just words but by living it every moment of his human existence. For Jesus, humility it is the way in which he conducts his life always, because this is the way in heaven, this is the way of God sharing himself with all creation. This is the way to greatness in the eyes of God, as possibly only God will know our attitude of humility, and others will just notice it at their convenience. God will remember those humble deeds and he will bring the reward at the resurrection on the last day.

To have this purpose in life would set our hearts on the path of humble service. But if we don't take this path of humility as a way of our life, it is because we don't have strong conviction about its necessity, and even we may see humility as a negative value, holding us back from apparent success of our personal agenda. It is not very much "human", to be the first to serve and happy to take the last place. It is very counter cultural, as our culture tells us to be the best, to be the first, to be ahead of everyone. Humility is seen as a form of weakness rather than strength, so no wonder we find it difficult to strive for it. This is why, to desire humility one has to be very much aware of God and his love. It is a rare gift, let's strive to be so close to God, as to know the value of it and practice it.

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos,

Nos alegra saber que Nuestro Señor nunca está de vacaciones y siempre está sosteniéndonos en cada momento de nuestra existencia, brindándonos lo que necesitamos y lo que es mejor para nosotros. Estamos en constante Comunión de vida con Dios aun cuando perdamos la conciencia de ello. Ser conscientes de esta dependencia total, nos llevaría a donde nos quieren llevar las lecturas de este Domingo, hacia la humildad en todas las cosas de la vida.

Nuestro orgullo proviene de nuestro instinto de conservación, pero la verdadera humildad proviene de la comunión con Dios y darle gloria, admiración y gratitud. No busquen el primer lugar: «Cuando seas convidado por alguien a una boda, no te pongas en el primer puesto» (Lc 14,8). Jesucristo sabe que nos gusta ponernos en el primer lugar: en los actos públicos, en casa, en la mesa, etc... Él conoce nuestra tendencia a sobrevalorarnos por vanidad, o todavía peor, por orgullo mal disimulado. ¡Estemos prevenidos con los honores!.

El Señor, nos propone que, por precaución, elijamos el último sitio, porque, si bien desconocemos la realidad íntima de los otros, sabemos muy bien que nosotros somos irrelevantes en el gran espectáculo del universo. Por tanto, situarnos en el último lugar es ir a lo seguro. No fuera caso que el Señor, que nos conoce a todos desde nuestras intimidades, nos tuviese que decir: «Deja el sitio a éste», y entonces vayamos a ocupar avergonzado el último puesto» (Lc 14,9).

El Maestro nos invita a ponernos con toda humildad al lado de los preferidos de Dios: pobres, inválidos, cojos y ciegos, y a igualarnos con ellos hasta encontrarnos en medio de quienes Dios ama con especial ternura, y a superar toda repugnancia y vergüenza por compartir mesa y amistad con ellos.

"Voyant comment ils choisissaient les premières places, Jésus leur proposa cette parabole"

Frères et Soeurs bien Aime,

Aujourd'hui, Jésus nous donne une leçon magistrale: ne cherchez pas la première place: «Quand tu es invité à des noces, ne va pas te mettre à la première place» (Lc 14,8). Jésus-Christ sait que nous aimons nous mettre en premier lieu: dans les actes publics, dans les rencontres amicales, à la maison, à table... Il connaît bien notre tendance à nous surestimer par arrogance. Pire encore! Par orgueil mal dissimulé. Soyons alertés contre les honneurs!, puisque «le cœur prend racine là où il trouve la possibilité de jouissance» (Saint Léon I, le Grand).

En effet, qui nous dit qu'il n'y a pas des collègues avec plus de mérites ou avec une catégorie personnelle plus grande? Il ne s'agit guère d'un fait sporadique, mais de l'attitude bien assumée de nous juger les plus intelligents, les plus importants, ceux qui ont plus de mérites ou plus de discernement; ambition qui suppose une conception étroite sur nous-mêmes et sur tout ce qui nous entoure.

En réalité, Jésus nous invite à la pratique de la contrition parfaite, consistant à ne pas nous juger ni à juger les autres, ainsi qu'à prendre conscience de notre insignifiance individuelle dans le concert global du cosmos et de la vie.

Dans cette même ligne de pensée, le Maître nous invite à nous mettre humblement au côté des ceux qui Dieu préfère: les pauvres, les estropiés, les aveugles, les boiteux, en nous mettant à leur hauteur jusqu'à nous trouver au beau milieu de ceux qui Dieu aime avec une tendresse spéciale, aussi bien qu'à surmonter tout le dégoût et honte de devoir partager notre table et notre amitié avec eux.

The generosity of the parishioners of St. Anne Parish allows us to reach out to people in our Brentwood/Bay Shore neighborhood who struggle each day to make ends meet. Thank you to all who generously donate to our food pantry. During June 2022, we were happy to assist 169 families, 46 seniors, 230 adults and 192 children. We also helped 8 new families.

SCHOOL IS FINISHED FOR THE YEAR AND OUR OUTREACH IS NOW REQUESTING SCHOOL SUPPLIES

for the school year 2022-2023. The supply list is always very extensive: composition notebooks (no spiral notebooks), Ticonderoga #2 pencils, pens, colored pencils, Crayola crayons, glue, glue sticks, Fiscar scissors, highlighters, dry erase markers, thin washable markers, rulers, ruled index cards, pencil cases with zippers, 1" and 2" binders, dividers with tabs (for binders), loose leaf paper, 2-pocket folders (laminated or plastic), lunch bags and backpacks. Any donated school supply item will be greatly appreciated.
