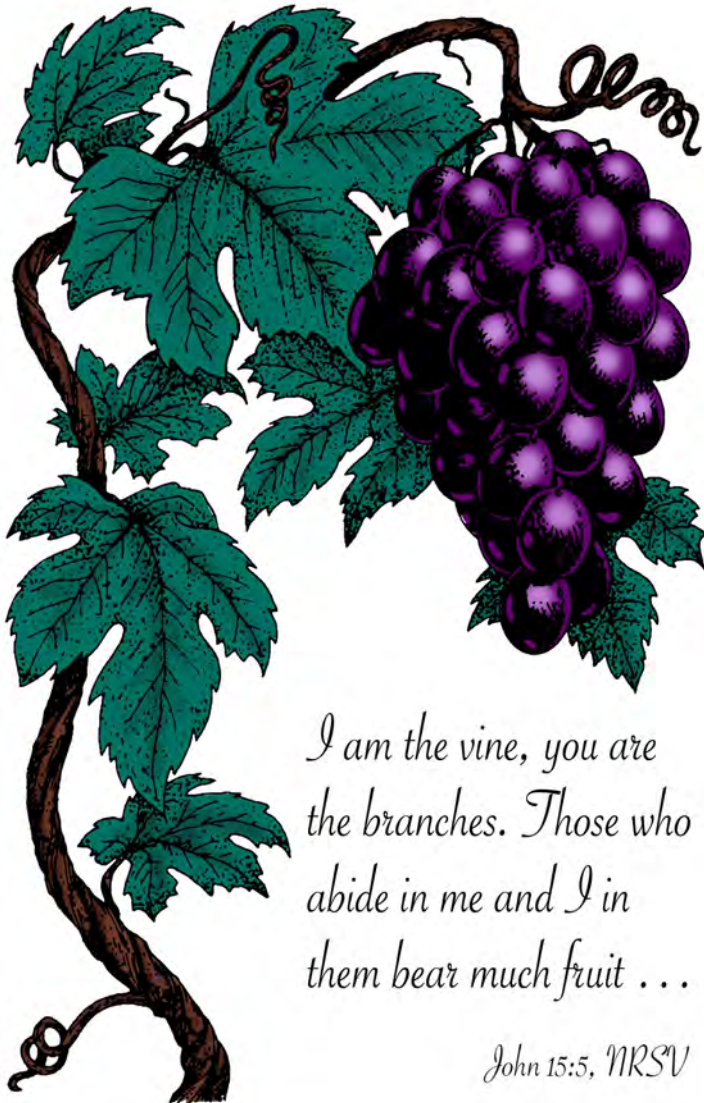

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The “calendar spring” started in March, but the change to warmer weather is perceived now with the visible signs of spring flowers, trees blooming, and grass starting to take off. We could say it is all fruit of the Resurrection of Jesus, that brings new life to every aspect of our lives. An Easter lily is one of the symbols of Resurrection, dressed in a “white cloth,” that was left by Christ in the tomb, creating a harmony with it. It is a beautiful feeling to perceive the spring as a fruit of the Resurrection, as a consequence of it. Without the Resurrection, the spring was destined to die permanently one day, but with the Resurrection it is destined to be eternal like Christ. If there is beauty in newness of life, Christ makes it eternal, unending. By faith in Christ, we acquire rights to that eternal spring. Like that grain of wheat from the parable, that sown to the ground is lost to itself, but it comes back to life in multiple seeds with great fruitfulness and infinite perspective of becoming countless.

In the parable of this Sunday, Jesus compares our dependence on the Resurrection, on Jesus, to the fruitfulness and growth of the vine, that is dependent on being connected to the stem of the vine prepared to power all necessary growth and fruitfulness of this vine. The vine needs to be pruned in order to produce the good fruits, and the new branch by itself cannot produce the fruits without total dependence on the old stem of the vine.

Without Christ, there is no Resurrection. Without Christ, there is no eternal life. Without Christ, life ends in the tomb. Lord, give us that gift of eternal life, give us the blessings of friendship with You. Friendship that will carry us to eternal life with you.

Last Sunday we accepted Jesus as our Good Shepherd to guide us to the eternal pastures. This Sunday we have 29 children and youth to receive their Baptism in preparation later for their First Communion, when they will be invited to nourish themselves for eternal life, to receive the abundance of blessings along the path of life and fullness of happiness from Jesus. The Baptism makes us to become the branches inserted into the stem of the vine that is Jesus himself. It makes us one with Christ in life, in death and in resurrection. It makes us one with the Mystical Body of Christ that is the Church. The Baptism makes us Catholic; it makes us children of God. It makes us the heirs to the inheritance that Jesus leaves for those who believe in him. There is no happiness without Christ, with Him there is the abundance of happiness and fullness of joy.

Let us not lose the appreciation of the love and sacrifice that Jesus shared with us, let us treasure it and grow in intimate friendship with Christ. Let us be driven to become faithful friends of Jesus, worthy of the gifts of his love.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

El “calendario de primavera” comenzó en marzo, pero el cambio a un clima más cálido se percibe ahora con los signos visibles de flores primaverales, árboles floreciendo y pasto comenzando a crecer. Podríamos decir que es todo fruto de la Resurrección de Jesús, que trae vida nueva a cada aspecto de nuestra vida. Un lirio de Pascua es uno de los símbolos de la Resurrección, vestido con un “pañó blanco”, que dejó Cristo en el sepulcro, creando una armonía con él. Es un hermoso sentimiento percibir la primavera como fruto de la Resurrección, como consecuencia de ella. Sin la Resurrección, la fuente estaba destinada a morir permanentemente algún día, pero con la Resurrección está destinada a ser eterna como Cristo. Si hay belleza en la novedad de la vida, Cristo la hace eterna, interminable. Por la fe en Cristo, adquirimos derechos a esa eterna primavera. Como ese grano de trigo de la parábola, que sembrado en la tierra se pierde para sí mismo, pero vuelve a la vida en múltiples semillas con gran fecundidad y perspectiva infinita de volverse incontable.

En la parábola de este domingo, Jesús compara nuestra dependencia de la Resurrección, de Jesús, con la fecundidad y el crecimiento de la vid, que depende de estar conectados al tallo de la vid preparado para impulsar todo el crecimiento y la fecundidad necesarios de esta vid. La vid necesita ser podada para producir buenos frutos, y la nueva rama por sí sola no puede producir los frutos sin una dependencia total del tallo viejo de la vid.

Sin Cristo no hay Resurrección. Sin Cristo no hay vida eterna. Sin Cristo, la vida termina en la tumba. Señor, danos ese regalo de la vida eterna, danos las bendiciones de la amistad contigo. Amistad que nos llevará a la vida eterna contigo.

El domingo pasado aceptamos a Jesús como nuestro Buen Pastor para guiarnos a los pastos eternos. Este domingo tenemos 29 niños y jóvenes para recibir su Bautismo en preparación posterior a su Primera Comunión, cuando serán invitados a alimentarse para la vida eterna, para recibir la abundancia de bendiciones en el camino de la vida y la plenitud de felicidad de parte de Jesús. El Bautismo nos hace convertirnos en los sarmientos insertados en el tallo de la vid que es Jesús mismo. Nos hace uno con Cristo en la vida, en la muerte y en la resurrección. Nos hace uno con el Cuerpo Místico de Cristo que es la Iglesia. El Bautismo nos hace católicos; nos hace hijos de Dios. Nos hace herederos de la herencia que Jesús deja a quienes creen en él. No hay felicidad sin Cristo, con Él hay abundancia de felicidad y plenitud de gozo.

No perdamos el aprecio por el amor y el sacrificio que Jesús compartió con nosotros, atesorémoslo y crezcamos en una amistad íntima con Cristo. Dejémonos impulsar a convertirnos en amigos fieles de Jesús, dignos de los dones de su amor.

'Sin mí, no pueden hacer nada'

De lo que dice Jesús se desprende claramente que sólo aquellas ramas que están conectadas al tronco pueden dar fruto. "Separados de mí no podéis hacer nada." Sin fruto somos ramas muertas, pero, por otro lado, el fruto no es sólo de nuestra propia elaboración.

Es la señal de que Cristo está obrando en nosotros y a través de nosotros. El fruto más destacado de todo es, por supuesto, el amor que revelamos en nuestras interacciones con Dios y con las personas. "En esto conocerán todos que sois mis discípulos, que os amáis los unos a los otros."

Separados de Cristo -siempre fruto de nuestra propia elección- somos como una rama que ha caído del árbol. Nos marchitamos. Estas "ramas se recogen y se arrojan al fuego, y luego se queman". Esa separación no es física. Es una separación de identidad. Proviene de rechazar o negarnos a aceptar el Camino de Jesús como nuestra forma de vida. Es un rechazo de la vida y de la elección de alternativas que sólo pueden conducir a la decadencia y la muerte.

"Si permanecéis en mí y mis palabras permanecen en vosotros, podéis pedir lo que queráis y lo obtendréis". Necesitamos estar EN Cristo y tener nuestra vida totalmente guiada por sus "palabras", es decir, su enseñanza, su visión de la vida. Esto lo confirma aún más la segunda lectura de hoy: "No debemos tener miedo en la presencia de Dios, y todo lo que le pidamos lo recibiremos, porque guardamos sus mandamientos y vivimos el modo de vida que él quiere".

Celui qui demeure en moi porte beaucoup de fruit

Dans le texte d'aujourd'hui, l'expression «porter du fruit» est répétée six fois en quelques lignes. Ce sont les fruits et non les belles paroles qui nous identifient en tant que disciples du Christ : «ce ne sont pas ceux et celles qui disent <Seigneur, Seigneur> qui entreront dans le royaume des cieus, mais ceux et celles qui font la volonté de mon Père» (Mt 7, 21). Jésus condamne le figuier stérile qui n'avait que des feuilles. Il réproche le servent inutile qui enterre son talent. Il reproche aux pharisiens de ne pas faire les œuvres de leur père Abraham (Jn 8, 39, Mt 3, 9). «C'est à leurs fruits que vous les reconnaitrez» (Mt 7, 16).

Frères et Sœurs Bien Aime , Notre foi peut se développer si elle est vivante, si elle joue un rôle actif dans notre vie de tous les jours, si elle porte du fruit. C'est pourquoi nous venons rencontrer le Seigneur chaque dimanche afin d'écouter sa parole et reprendre des forces pour la semaine qui commence.

Porter du fruit ne veut pas dire faire des choses extraordinaires, ça veut dire bien faire les choses ordinaires. Rattachés au Christ comme les sarments à la vigne, éclairés par l'Esprit Saint, nous pouvons alors donner du fruit en abondance.

Les fruits de l'Esprit, nous dit Saint Paul sont : «l'amour, la joie, la paix, la patience, la bonté, la douceur, la fidélité, la tendresse, la capacité de contrôler nos colères»... Dieu a besoin de nous pour créer un monde meilleur, un monde de respect, de fraternité et d'amour. Il a besoin de nos mains, de nos pieds, de notre coeur dans un univers souvent sans merci pour les plus faibles.

Les textes d'aujourd'hui rappellent que si nous sommes unis au Christ, comme les sarments à la vigne, nous recevrons sa force et sa vie, nous nous aimerons les uns les autres et nous porterons beaucoup de fruit. «Celui qui demeure en moi porte beaucoup de fruit».

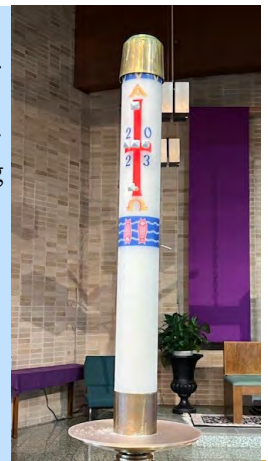
