Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This weekend we celebrate a unique feast — not of a saint or an event in Christ's life, but of a church building: the Archbasilica of the Most Holy Savior and of Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist at the Lateran, better known as the Lateran Basilica. The Lateran Basilica is the cathedral of Rome — the Pope's own church — and holds the title "Mother and head of all the churches of the city and of the world." It was the first church built after Emperor Constantine legalized Christianity by The Edict of Milan issued in the year 313 A.D. by the Roman emperors Constantine the Great (who ruled the West) and Licinius (who ruled the East). It granted religious freedom throughout the empire and, most importantly, legalized Christianity after nearly three centuries of intermittent persecution. Before this decree, Christians had suffered under waves of imperial hostility, particularly during the reigns of emperors Decius and Diocletian. Churches were destroyed, sacred books burned, and many believers martyred for refusing to worship the Roman gods or the emperor.

The Edict of Milan changed everything. It declared that "Christians and all others should have freedom to follow the religion which they choose" and ordered that confiscated Christian property be returned. This was not only a practical change but a profound shift in Roman policy — from suppression to tolerance. Under Constantine's protection, Christianity began to flourish. Churches were built openly (including the Lateran Basilica in Rome, the first major Christian church), bishops could meet in councils, and the faith spread rapidly across the empire. The Edict of Milan thus marks the beginning of the Church's public life and the end of the age of persecution. It set the stage for Christianity to become a vital force in Western civilization and, eventually, the official religion of the empire under Emperor Theodosius at the end of the 4th century.

Lateran Basilica was dedicated in the year 324 A.D. by Pope Sylvester I. For over a thousand years, the Popes lived and governed the Church from the Lateran Palace next to the basilica. Although its dedication is a local Roman anniversary, the feast is celebrated by the entire Church to remind us that the unity of all believers is built upon the faith handed down from the apostles and safeguarded by the successor of Peter. The Lateran stands as a sign of that unity — a visible reminder that we are one family of faith spread across the world.

But this feast points beyond stone and marble. As St. Paul teaches, "You are God's building... God's temple is holy, and you are that temple." Each of us is a living stone in God's spiritual house. Just as the Lateran Basilica has been rebuilt and renewed over centuries, so too must our hearts be continually renewed to remain worthy dwelling places for the Lord. As we honor the "Mother Church of Christendom," may we also renew our love and reverence for our own parish church, the local sign of God's dwelling among His people. And may our lives reflect the holiness of the living temple that is the Body of Christ.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

Este fin de semana celebramos una fiesta única — no la de un santo ni un acontecimiento en la vida de Cristo, sino la de un edificio sagrado: la Arquidiócesis del Santísimo Salvador y de los Santos Juan Bautista y Juan Evangelista en el Laterano, más conocida como la Basílica de Letrán.

La Basílica de Letrán es la catedral de Roma, la iglesia del mismo Papa, y lleva el título de “Madre y cabeza de todas las iglesias de la ciudad y del mundo.” Fue la primera iglesia construida después de que el emperador Constantino legalizara el cristianismo mediante el Edicto de Milán, promulgado en el año 313 d.C. por los emperadores romanos Constantino el Grande (que gobernaba Occidente) y Licinio (que gobernaba Oriente). Dicho edicto otorgó libertad religiosa en todo el Imperio y, lo más importante, legalizó el cristianismo tras casi tres siglos de persecuciones intermitentes. Antes de este decreto, los cristianos habían sufrido olas de hostilidad imperial, especialmente durante los reinados de los emperadores Decio y Diocleciano. Se destruyeron iglesias, se quemaron libros sagrados y muchos creyentes fueron martirizados por negarse a adorar a los dioses romanos o al emperador.

El Edicto de Milán lo cambió todo. Declaró que “los cristianos y todos los demás deben tener libertad para seguir la religión que elijan” y ordenó que se devolvieran las propiedades confiscadas a los cristianos. Esto no solo fue un cambio práctico, sino un profundo giro en la política romana, que pasó de la represión a la tolerancia. Bajo la protección de Constantino, el cristianismo comenzó a florecer: se construyeron templos abiertamente (incluida la Basílica de Letrán en Roma, la primera gran iglesia cristiana), los obispos pudieron reunirse en concilios, y la fe se propagó rápidamente por todo el imperio. Así, el Edicto de Milán marca el inicio de la vida pública de la Iglesia y el fin de la era de las persecuciones. Preparó el camino para que el cristianismo se convirtiera en una fuerza vital de la civilización occidental y, finalmente, en la religión oficial del Imperio bajo el emperador Teodosio, a finales del siglo IV.

La Basílica de Letrán fue dedicada en el año 324 d.C. por el papa Silvestre I. Durante más de mil años, los papas vivieron y gobernaron la Iglesia desde el Palacio de Letrán, junto a la basílica. Aunque su dedicación es una conmemoración local romana, la fiesta se celebra en toda la Iglesia para recordarnos que la unidad de todos los creyentes se edifica sobre la fe transmitida por los apóstoles y custodiada por el sucesor de Pedro. El Letrán es un signo visible de esa unidad: un recordatorio de que somos una sola familia de fe extendida por todo el mundo.

Pero esta fiesta va más allá de la piedra y el mármol. Como enseña san Pablo: “Ustedes son edificio de Dios... El templo de Dios es santo, y ese templo son ustedes.” Cada uno de nosotros es una piedra viva en la casa espiritual de Dios. Así como la Basílica de Letrán ha sido reconstruida y renovada a lo largo de los siglos, también nuestros corazones deben renovarse continuamente para ser moradas dignas del Señor. Al honrar a la “Iglesia Madre de la cristiandad,” renovemos también nuestro amor y reverencia por nuestra propia iglesia parroquial, signo local de la presencia de Dios entre su pueblo. Y que nuestras vidas reflejen la santidad del templo vivo que es el Cuerpo de Cristo. ¡

November 9 th ,2025 Fête de la Dédicace de la Basilique du Latran

Évangile : Jean 2, 13-22

Frères et sœurs,

aujourd’hui, l’Église célèbre la Dédicace de la Basilique du Latran, la cathédrale de l’évêque de Rome, le pape. Cette fête nous rappelle que nous ne formons pas seulement une communauté spirituelle dispersée, mais un peuple rassemblé dans une maison, la maison de Dieu, signe visible de l’unité de toute l’Église.

Dans l’Évangile de ce jour, Jésus entre dans le Temple de Jérusalem et y découvre le désordre : les vendeurs, les changeurs, le commerce. Alors il renverse les tables et proclame :

« Ne faites pas de la maison de mon Père une maison de commerce ! »

Ce geste fort n’est pas seulement un coup de colère. Il exprime un désir de purification : Jésus veut que le Temple redevienne un lieu de rencontre avec Dieu, un lieu de prière et de vérité.

Et plus encore, il annonce un mystère :

« Détruisez ce Temple, et en trois jours je le relèverai. »

Jean nous dit : « Il parlait du temple de son corps. »

Frères et sœurs, voilà le cœur de notre fête. La basilique du Latran, comme toutes nos églises, est importante parce qu’elle manifeste visiblement la présence du Christ au milieu de nous.

Mais le vrai Temple, c’est le Christ lui-même, et, par lui, chacun de nous :

« Ne savez-vous pas que vous êtes le temple de Dieu, et que l’Esprit de Dieu habite en vous ? » (1 Co 3,16)

Célébrer aujourd’hui la Dédicace d’une église, c’est donc nous rappeler que notre cœur doit être lui aussi consacré, purifié, offert à Dieu.

Jésus veut y chasser tout ce qui nous encombre — nos fausses sécurités, nos idoles, nos compromis — pour y faire sa demeure.

Alors, demandons au Seigneur en ce jour :

qu’il fasse de nos communautés, de nos familles et de nos vies des temples vivants de sa présence,

où l’on puisse reconnaître son amour, sa paix et sa lumière.

Amen.

PARISH OUTREACH NEWS

The generosity of the parishioners of St. Anne Parish allows us to reach out to people in our Brentwood/Bay Shore neighborhood who struggle every day to make ends meet.

Thank you to all who donate to our food pantry. **During October 2025**, we were happy to assist 338 families, 103 seniors, 477 adults and 353 children. We also helped 13 new families.

For Thanksgiving, we will be giving our pantry clients extra food for their Thanksgiving meal. We graciously accept any donated food items to help during this season of giving. For Thanksgiving, we need canned beans, dry beans, rice, soups, pasta, juices, cereals, gravy, stuffing mix, chicken or turkey broth, snacks, cake mixes and pies.
