
Happy 4th of July !!! Happy Independence Day !!!

An overview of the criminal justice process from arrest through conviction is provided along with a detailed description of the rights of crime victims and the services they are entitled to under the Law.





Accueillir l'autre

Accueillir l'autre, c'est tout autant écouter ses confidences, partager ses joies, que le comprendre à demi-mot. C'est à l'accueil que nous réservons au plus petit des croyants que se mesure notre accueil du Christ lui-même. La première lecture représente une sorte de parabole de l'hospitalité orientale. Grâce à l'entremise du prophète Élisée, la générosité de la Sunamite sera récompensée au-delà de qu'elle osait espérer. C'est aussi d'accueil et de disponibilité qu'il est question dans l'Evangile de Matthieu qui nous est présenté aujourd'hui. Quiconque accueille le disciple accueille aussi le maître, et accueillir Jésus, c'est accueillir le Père qui l'a envoyé. Que le messager soit un prophète, un juste ou un simple disciple, l'enjeu est le même: en accueillant ou en refusant l'un de ces émissaires, c'est Dieu même qu'on accueille ou qu'on refuse. Mais, ce Dieu n'est pas la simple projection de nos rêves. Il nous dit par son Fils: " Qui veut garder sa vie pour soi la perdra; qui perdra sa vie à cause de moi la gardera."
