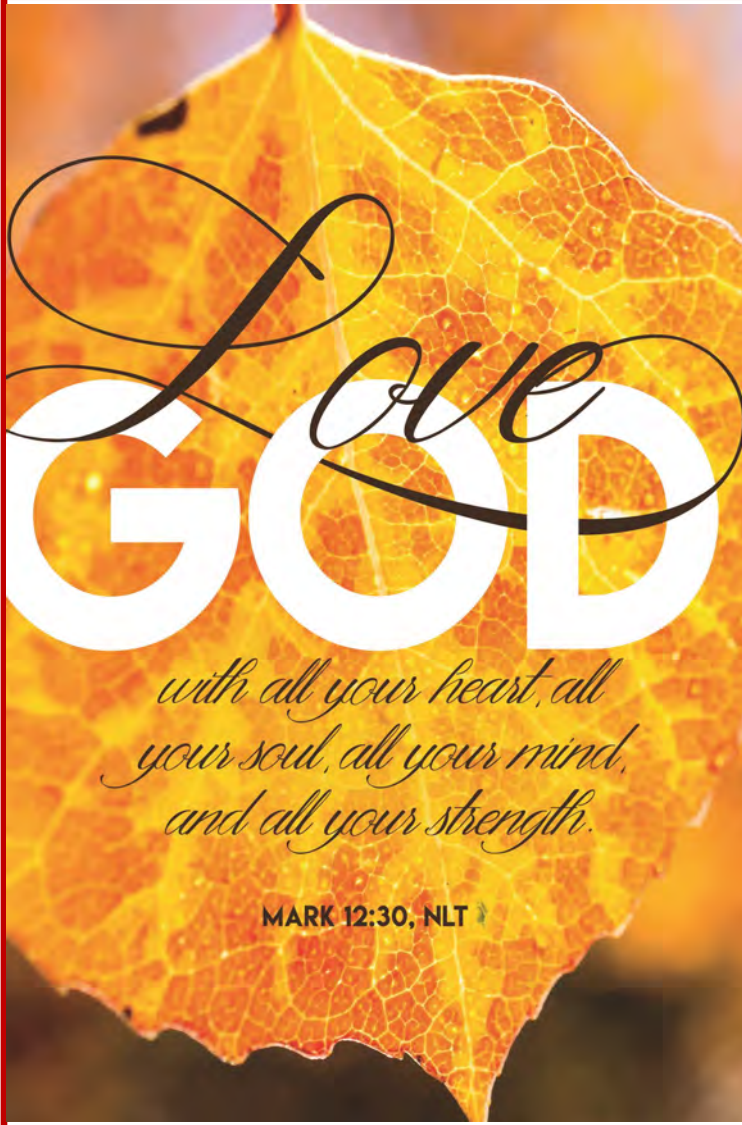

El pasaje del Evangelio de este domingo según San Marcos (12, 28-34), donde un escriba se acerca a Jesús para preguntarle cuál es el mandamiento más importante. La respuesta de Jesús es clara y profunda: amar a Dios con todo nuestro corazón, alma, mente y fuerzas, y amar a nuestro prójimo como a nosotros mismos.

Este diálogo nos invita a considerar la esencia de nuestra fe. En un mundo lleno de distracciones y divisiones, Jesús nos recuerda que el amor debe ser el fundamento de nuestra vida. Amar a Dios significa tener una relación personal y sincera con Él, dedicando tiempo a la oración y la reflexión. Pero ese amor no se queda solo en la devoción; se extiende hacia nuestros hermanos y hermanas.

Al amar a nuestro prójimo, estamos llamados a ver a Cristo en los demás, a ser compasivos y a actuar con justicia. Cada acto de bondad, cada gesto de apoyo, es una manifestación del amor que Dios nos pide.

El escriba reconoce que este mandamiento de amor es más importante que cualquier sacrificio o ritual. Esto nos recuerda que nuestra práctica de fe debe ir acompañada de acciones concretas de amor y servicio hacia los demás.

Hoy, reflexionemos sobre cómo estamos viviendo estos mandamientos en nuestra vida diaria. ¿Estamos amando a Dios de todo corazón? ¿Estamos dispuestos a amar y servir a nuestro prójimo? Que el amor sea la guía de nuestras acciones y que, al hacerlo, seamos verdaderos discípulos de Cristo.

### 31eme Dimanche du Temps Ordinaire.B

Tu n'es pas loin du Royaume de Dieu

Cette semaine, nous avons célébré deux des plus grandes fêtes de l'année liturgique : la fête de tous les Saints et la fête de tous les Fidèles défunts. En début novembre, nous nous souvenons de cette longue chaîne de témoins qui nous ont précédés...

Nous les chrétiens, nous ne croyons pas à une mort cruelle où tout se termine au tombeau.

Nous croyons dans un paradis où la vie se transforme et change. Nous croyons que la mort est un seuil, un passage, une porte ouverte sur l'éternité.

Dans le livre du prophète Isaïe, nous trouvons ce très beau texte :

«Le Seigneur essuiera toutes les larmes de nos visages... sur sa sainte montagne, il préparera une fête de riche nourriture... il fera disparaître la mort pour toujours... Réjouissons-nous dans le salut du Seigneur.»

Nous vivons alors la paix du Royaume de Dieu où :

Et saint Jean ajoute dans son Apocalypse : «Je vis un ciel nouveau, une terre nouvelle... Voici la demeure de Dieu avec les hommes. Il aura sa demeure avec eux; ils seront son peuple, et lui, Dieu-avec-eux (Emmanuel), sera leur Dieu.

Il essuiera toute larme de leurs yeux : de mort, il n'y en aura plus; de pleurs, de cri et de peine, il n'y en aura plus, car l'ancien monde s'en est allé.» (Ap 21, 1-4)

Il y a plein d'espérance dans ces fêtes de novembre. Ça nous rappelle que la mort n'est pas la fin de tout. Ça nous rappelle aussi que le temps qui nous est donné est un don précieux et que nous devons l'utiliser le mieux possible.
