Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The Gospel begins with a question that many of us, deep down, still ask: “Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?” It’s not a shallow or hypothetical question. It gets to the heart of our faith: What does God want from me? What really matters in the end?

Jesus doesn’t answer directly at first. Instead, He reflects the question back to the scholar: What is written in the law? The man responds well—love God with all your heart, soul, strength, and mind, and love your neighbor as yourself. Jesus agrees: “Do this and you will live.” But the scholar wants clarification, or perhaps a loophole and so he asks: “And who is my neighbor?”

That’s when Jesus tells the story of the Good Samaritan—a story that does more than define who our neighbor is. It challenges us to become the kind of person who treats everyone as neighbor. The Samaritan in the parable is someone no one expected to be the hero. Yet he’s the one who truly fulfills the law—not by theory, but through mercy in action. He crosses boundaries, risks himself, and gives generously to heal the wounded man. Jesus ends by saying: “Go and do likewise.” And that brings us back to the first question: What must I do to inherit eternal life?

According to Jesus, the answer is not just believing or knowing the right answers. It’s about living a life of love, of compassion, of mercy. A life that mirrors the heart of Christ, who is—Paul tells us today—the image of the invisible God. This week, let’s not rush past that first question. Let’s hold it in prayer: Lord, what must I do to truly live? Who are you calling me to love more fully today? Those two questions are bound together and the answer is one of service out of love for God and for Christ that we want to make daily. God bless everyone always!!!

The Good Samaritan

Queridas hermanas y hermanos:

El Evangelio de hoy comienza con una pregunta que todos, en el fondo, todavía nos hacemos: “Maestro, ¿qué tengo que hacer para heredar la vida eterna?” No es una pregunta superficial ni hipotética. Va al corazón de nuestra fe: ¿Qué quiere Dios de mí? ¿Qué es lo que realmente importa al final?

Jesús no responde directamente al principio. En cambio, le devuelve la pregunta al maestro de la ley: ¿Qué está escrito en la ley? El hombre responde bien: amar a Dios con todo el corazón, el alma, la fuerza y la mente, y amar al prójimo como a uno mismo. Jesús está de acuerdo: “Haz esto y vivirás.” Pero el maestro de la ley quiere una aclaración—o tal vez una escapatoria—y entonces pregunta: “¿Y quién es mi prójimo?”

Es entonces cuando Jesús cuenta la parábola del Buen Samaritano. Esta historia no solo define quién es nuestro prójimo; nos desafía a convertirnos en personas que tratan a todos como prójimos. El samaritano es alguien que nadie esperaba que fuera el héroe del relato. Sin embargo, él es quien cumple verdaderamente la ley, no en teoría, sino mediante la misericordia en acción. Cruza fronteras, se arriesga, y da generosamente para sanar al hombre herido. Jesús concluye diciendo: “Ve, y haz tú lo mismo.” Y eso nos lleva de nuevo a la primera pregunta ¿Qué debo hacer para heredar la vida eterna? Según Jesús, la respuesta no está solo en creer o saber las respuestas correctas. Se trata de vivir una vida de amor, de compasión, de misericordia. Una vida que refleje el corazón de Cristo, quien—nos dice hoy San Pablo—es la imagen del Dios invisible. Esta semana, no pasemos por alto esa primera pregunta. Sostengámosla en la oración: Señor, ¿qué tengo que hacer para vivir de verdad? ¿A quién me estás llamando a amar más profundamente hoy? Esas dos preguntas están unidas, y la respuesta es una vida de servicio por amor a Dios y a Cristo, un compromiso que queremos renovar cada día.

¡Que Dios los bendiga siempre!

"Va, toi aussi fais de même
et tu vivras"



Nous connaissons trop bien cette parabole du bon Samaritain. Elle offre cependant plusieurs points importants pour notre réflexion chrétienne.

« Tu aimeras le Seigneur ton Dieu de tout ton cœur... tu aimeras ton prochain comme toi-même »... Ils savent ce qu'il faut faire mais ne le font pas. Ce qui intéresse Jésus, ce n'est pas tellement d'avoir les bonnes réponses, mais d'agir selon les lois de Dieu.

Le samaritain, un hérétique, un ennemi des juifs, un homme qui n'a jamais mis les pieds dans le Temple, un homme qu'il faut éviter et qu'il est interdit d'inviter à sa table, lui sait ce qu'il doit faire et il le fait : « Il fut saisi de pitié...! » Il a été pris aux entrailles, pris aux tripes.

C'est donc le Samaritain et non le prêtre et le lévite qui met en pratique la loi de Dieu.

Une autre question importante dans cette parabole : Qui est mon prochain ? L'homme de loi avait une idée bien précise sur le sujet. Jésus bouleverse complètement la notion de « prochain »... Le prochain, ce n'est pas mon voisin, ce n'est pas celui qui est blessé et dans le besoin... Le prochain, c'est vous, c'est moi lorsque nous nous rapprochons de quelqu'un qui souffre!

Le légiste qui était venu pour prendre Jésus au piège se voit donc obligé d'admettre que le Samaritain, l'exclus, et non pas le prêtre ou le lévite a été celui qui s'est montré le prochain de l'homme tombé aux mains des voleurs de grands chemins.

Le Samaritain ne demande pas si l'homme blessé est un compatriote, un ami, un homme de la même religion. C'est une personne qui a besoin d'aide et cela suffit.

Jésus donne le coup de grâce au légiste en le mettant au défi d'agir de la même façon : « Va et fais de même ». Tu as donné la bonne réponse, tu sais ce qu'il faut faire. Agis comme le Samaritain et tu vivras...

À nous de nous poser la question aujourd'hui :

Qui est le prochain du vieillard qui souffre de solitude et ne peut se déplacer?

- de la femme abandonnée par son mari et par ses enfants?

- du voisin qui vient de perdre son emploi et qui se demande comment il va faire vivre sa famille...

Est-ce que je me fais le prochain de ces gens dans le besoin?

« La loi du Seigneur n'est pas au-dessus de tes forces et hors de ton atteinte », affirme la première lecture.

Être chrétien, c'est pas compliqué. Il s'agit d'avoir le cœur et les yeux ouverts. On ne sert pas Dieu dans le temple si on ne le sert pas d'abord dans la rue et sur la route! Suis-je un chrétien « pratiquant »?

À la fin de chaque eucharistie, le Christ nous renvoie à nos occupations, à nos familles, à notre travail...

en nous disant : « souviens-toi du bon Samaritain... et toi, va, fais de même, et tu vivras. »
