Dear Sisters and Brothers,

One of the most beautiful moments in the Gospel this Sunday is the simple, heartfelt request made by one of Jesus' disciples: "Lord, teach us to pray." It's a request born not of pride, but of spiritual hunger. The disciple sees Jesus at prayer and senses that something deeply authentic and life-giving is happening—something they want to share in. In response, Jesus gives us the Lord's Prayer—not only words to recite, but a pattern for how to approach the Father: with trust, boldness, and reverence. The "Our Father" is more than a prayer; it is a way of living in right relationship—with God, with others, and even with our own needs and hopes.

This theme of bold, intercessory prayer is also found in the first reading from Genesis, where Abraham pleads with God to spare the city of Sodom if even a few righteous people can be found there. Abraham's persistence is not a challenge to God's justice, but a cry to His mercy. It reveals something essential: God welcomes our persistence. Prayer isn't about changing God's mind, but about drawing closer to His heart.

In the second reading, St. Paul reminds the Colossians (and us) that we are already made alive in Christ. Through our baptism, the debt of sin has been canceled. We pray not as outsiders seeking favor, but as beloved sons and daughters already drawn into divine life.

Today's readings invite us to examine our own life of prayer. Are we bold like Abraham? Trusting like the disciple? Do we believe Jesus when He says: "Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find"? Prayer isn't a magic formula—it's a relationship. It shapes us, softens us, strengthens us. This week, may we renew our commitment to daily prayer, and like that disciple long ago, may we too come before the Lord and say with open hearts: "Lord, teach us to pray."

This is really a great scripture theme for our parish feast of St. Anne and Joachim, something that for sure characterized the grandparents of Jesus and they were able to transmit it to their daughter Mary in whom the Word became Flesh! May they continue to intercede for us before God and their Grandson Jesus, so that our parish family be blessed with unwavering faith, hope and love!!! God bless everyone always!!!

Queridas hermanas y queridos hermanos,

Uno de los momentos más hermosos del Evangelio de este domingo es la sencilla y sincera petición que uno de los discípulos le hace a Jesús: “Señor, enséñanos a orar.” No es una súplica nacida del orgullo, sino del hambre espiritual. El discípulo ve a Jesús en oración y percibe que allí sucede algo profundamente auténtico y lleno de vida—algo en lo que también él quiere participar. En respuesta, Jesús nos entrega el Padre Nuestro—no solo palabras para recitar, sino un modelo de cómo dirigirnos al Padre: con confianza, con audacia y con reverencia. El “Padre Nuestro” es más que una oración; es una forma de vivir en relación correcta: con Dios, con los demás, e incluso con nuestras propias necesidades y esperanzas.

Este tema de la oración intercesora y audaz también aparece en la primera lectura del libro del Génesis, donde Abraham intercede ante Dios para que no destruya la ciudad de Sodoma si allí se encuentran aunque sea unos pocos justos. La perseverancia de Abraham no desafía la justicia de Dios, sino que clama por su misericordia. Nos revela algo fundamental: Dios acoge nuestra insistencia. Orar no se trata de cambiar la mente de Dios, sino de acercarnos más a su corazón.

En la segunda lectura, San Pablo recuerda a los colosenses (y también a nosotros) que ya hemos sido vivificados en Cristo. Por medio del bautismo, la deuda del pecado ha sido cancelada. Oramos no como extraños buscando un favor, sino como hijos e hijas amados, ya incorporados a la vida divina.

Las lecturas de hoy nos invitan a examinar nuestra propia vida de oración. ¿Somos audaces como Abraham? ¿Confiamos como el discípulo? ¿Creemos en Jesús cuando dice: “Pidan y se les dará; busquen y encontrarán”? La oración no es una fórmula mágica—es una relación. Nos moldea, nos ablanda, nos fortalece. Que esta semana podamos renovar nuestro compromiso con la oración diaria y, como aquel discípulo de hace siglos, también nosotros nos acerquemos al Señor con el corazón abierto y digamos: “Señor, enséñanos a orar.”

Este es verdaderamente un hermoso tema bíblico para nuestra fiesta parroquial de San Joaquín y Santa Ana, algo que sin duda caracterizó a los abuelos de Jesús y que supieron transmitir a su hija María, en quien el Verbo se hizo carne. ¡Que ellos sigan intercediendo por nosotros ante Dios y ante su nieto Jesús, para que nuestra familia parroquial sea bendecida con una fe, esperanza y caridad inquebrantables!

¡Que Dios los bendiga siempre!

Seigneur, apprends-nous à prier"

Ce dimanche nous offre une excellente occasion pour réfléchir sur la prière chrétienne. Dans la première lecture, Abraham, implore le Seigneur pour Sodome et Gomorrhe, démontrant une confiance totale en Dieu. Et Jésus propose ensuite, dans l'évangile, la prière par excellence, modèle de toutes les prières: le Notre Père. Comme nous le savons, Luc plus que tous les autres évangélistes, nous présente Jésus comme un homme de prière.

Et ses disciples, le voyant souvent se retirer pour prier, lui demandent de leur apprendre à prier. Ce jour-là, Jésus n'a pas enseigné à ses apôtres une prière, mais une manière d'entrer en contact avec Dieu. Chaque phrase du Notre Père pourrait faire jaillir une prière. L'Église, dès les premiers temps, a toujours utilisé de multiples formules dans ses liturgies, tout en conservant une unité de fond. Dans ce modèle de prière qu'est le Notre Père, nous prions d'abord pour le règne de Dieu.

Le Royaume de Dieu devient réalité dans la vie des gens lorsque notre monde est construit sur l'amour, la compassion, la justice, la liberté, la dignité humaine et la paix. Après avoir prié pour le règne de Dieu, le Notre Père nous invite à prier pour nous-mêmes.

Il ne s'agit pas d'une prière privée, mais d'une prière communautaire : «donne-nous notre pain de tous les jours... remets-nous nos offenses, comme nous les remettons... libère-nous du mal...» Nous prions toujours au pluriel, au nom de la communauté.

Le Notre Père n'est pas une abdication de nos responsabilités et une demande à Dieu d'agir à notre place. Ce pourquoi nous prions, Dieu nous demande de l'accomplir dans nos propres vies : Le règne de Dieu, le pain partagé, le pardon reçu et accordé, la libération du mal dans nos vies.

En tant que chrétien, il nous faut éviter de banaliser le Notre Père, de le répéter machinalement, comme s'il s'agissait d'une formule de prière quelconque. Le Christ a voulu nous enseigner «une manière de prier» qui puisse s'adapter à toutes les circonstances et à toutes les époques.

« Seigneur, apprends-nous à prier », apprends-nous à retrouver nos valeurs chrétiennes, à donner à Dieu la place qui lui revient et aux autres l'amour auquel ils ont droit.
