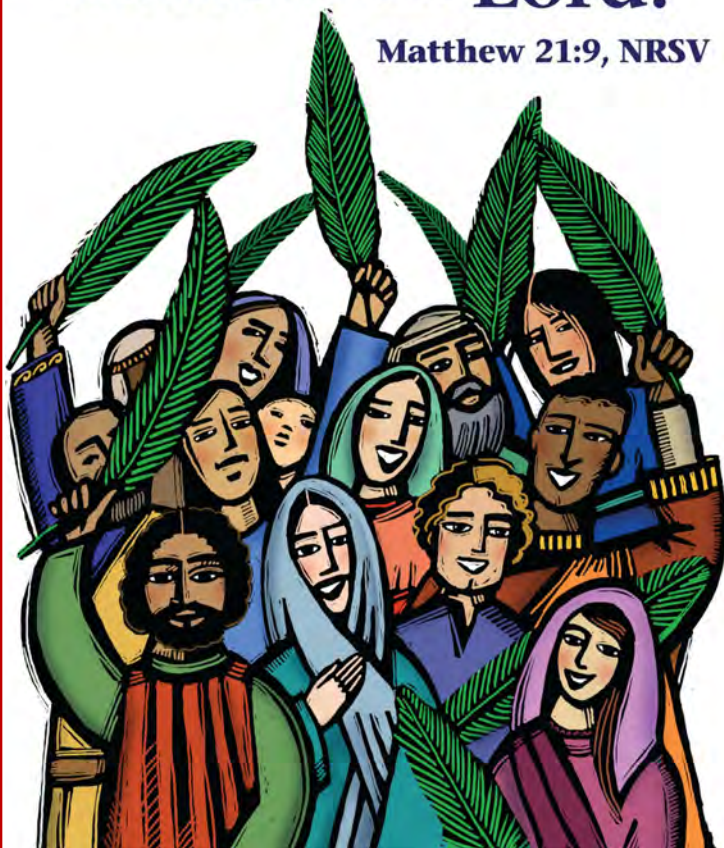

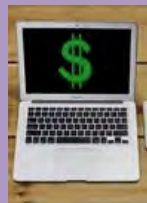

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

On Palm Sunday we begin the celebration of Holy Week, and we are invited to reflect on the powerful contrast of welcoming the King who embraces the Cross. We start with joy, waving palms and proclaiming, “Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord!” (Luke 19:38). Yet, just moments later, we enter into the solemn reading of Christ’s Passion, where the same crowd that welcomed Him will cry out, “Crucify Him!”



The Gospel of Luke presents Jesus as the merciful and suffering King. He enters Jerusalem humbly on a donkey, not as a warrior, but as the Prince of Peace. In His Passion, He continues to show compassion, even in suffering. He forgives His executioners, heals the servant’s ear, and promises paradise to the repentant thief. His final words, “Father, into your hands I commend my spirit,” (Luke 23:46) reveal His complete trust in the Father’s will.

Palm Sunday challenges us to ask: Where do we stand? Are we faithful followers, or do we turn away when discipleship becomes difficult? Like Peter, do we deny Him? Like Judas, do we betray Him for worldly desires? Or, like the Good Thief, do we turn to Him for mercy? Or are we just bystanders who follow the wave of crowd but not the Lord? Or are we just indifferent onlookers seeing the spectacle of culture and religion created by human leaders of different factions?

As we enter this most sacred week carrying the palms for Jesus, let us remain close to Him at every celebration of this week. Let us walk with Him through His Passion, knowing that the Cross is not the end—Easter is coming! May we be faithful disciples, welcoming Him not just with palms, but with hearts ready to follow Him wherever He leads, or discovering Him on our side as we walk the path traced by the limits of life. May this Holy Week be a time of renewal, mercy, and deep encounter with Christ.

To be participants with Jesus come to the celebrations of The Last Supper on Holy Thursday, The Way of The Cross on Good Friday and Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. The schedule you will find in the bulletin or on the parish website.

I want to thank all who prepared the reception for Deacon John and Sue Walters. It was a wonderful experience of sympathy and love shared with them in nice family gathering. Thank you all for stepping up to the occasion. God bless everyone always!!!

Queridas hermanas y hermanos,

En el Domingo de Ramos comenzamos la celebración de la Semana Santa, y se nos invita a reflexionar sobre el poderoso contraste de acoger al Rey que abraza la Cruz. Empezamos con alegría, agitando palmas y proclamando: "¡Bendito el Rey que viene en nombre del Señor!" (Lucas 19,38). Sin embargo, momentos después, entramos en la solemne lectura de la Pasión de Cristo, donde la misma multitud que lo recibió clamará: "¡Crucifícalo!"

El Evangelio de San Lucas presenta a Jesús como el Rey misericordioso y sufriente. Entra humildemente en Jerusalén montado en un burro, no como un guerrero, sino como el Príncipe de la Paz. En su Pasión, continúa mostrando compasión, incluso en medio del sufrimiento. Perdona a sus verdugos, cura la oreja del siervo y promete el paraíso al ladrón arrepentido. Sus últimas palabras, "Padre, en tus manos encomiendo mi espíritu" (Lucas 23,46), revelan su total confianza en la voluntad del Padre.

El Domingo de Ramos nos desafía a preguntarnos: ¿Dónde estamos nosotros? ¿Somos seguidores fieles, o nos alejamos cuando el discipulado se vuelve difícil? ¿Como Pedro, lo negamos? ¿Como Judas, lo traicionamos por deseos mundanos? ¿O, como el Buen Ladrón, nos volvemos hacia Él en busca de misericordia? ¿O simplemente somos espectadores que seguimos la corriente de la multitud sin seguir realmente al Señor? ¿O quizás somos indiferentes, mirando el espectáculo de cultura y religión creado por líderes humanos de diversas fracciones?

Al entrar en esta semana más sagrada, llevando las palmas para Jesús, permanezcamos cerca de Él en cada celebración. Caminemos con Él a través de su Pasión, sabiendo que la Cruz no es el final: ¡la Pascua se acerca! Que seamos discípulos fieles, recibéndolo no solo con palmas, sino con corazones dispuestos a seguirlo dondequiera que nos lleve, o descubriéndolo a nuestro lado mientras recorremos el camino trazado por los límites de la vida. Que esta Semana Santa sea un tiempo de renovación, misericordia y profundo encuentro con Cristo.

Para ser participantes junto a Jesús, acompañémoslo en las celebraciones: de la Última Cena el Jueves Santo, en el Vía Crucis el Viernes Santo y la Vigilia Pascual el Sábado Santo. El horario lo encontrará en el boletín o en el sitio web de la parroquia.

Quiero agradecer a todos los que prepararon la recepción para el Diácono John y Sue Walters. Fue una maravillosa experiencia de simpatía y amor compartido con ellos en una hermosa reunión familiar. ¡Gracias a todos por su generosidad y compromiso!

Que ce Dimanche des Rameaux nous aide à renouveler notre engagement envers Lui, à l'accueillir avec un cœur ouvert et à marcher avec Lui jusqu'à la croix, avec l'espérance ferme en la Résurrection.

Que la Très Sainte Vierge Marie, la Mère fidèle, nous accompagne en cette Semaine Sainte.

Amen.
