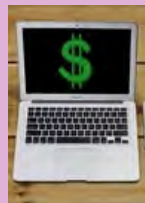

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

As we enter the Second Sunday of Advent, the Scriptures invite us into a deeper posture of hope and conversion. Today we meet John the Baptist, that bold and uncompromising figure crying out in the wilderness: “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!” (Mt 3:2). His message is not meant to instill fear, but to awaken hearts. Advent is not simply about preparing for Christmas festivities—it is a season of spiritual readiness. Christ comes not only in Bethlehem, but into every heart willing to receive Him.



The prophet Isaiah offers a vision of the Messiah unlike any earthly ruler: a shoot from the stump of Jesse, filled with the Spirit of wisdom, understanding, counsel, and strength (Is 11:1–10). This promised One brings harmony, justice, and peace—so complete that even natural enemies dwell together without fear. Isaiah’s vision reminds us that Advent hope is not wishful thinking, but a confident trust that God is at work, even when the world feels like a barren stump.

St. Paul reinforces this hope by encouraging the Christian community to “welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you” (Rom 15:7). Unity, patience, and encouragement are not optional virtues—they are the fruits of a people who know that God keeps His promises.

In this second week of Advent, we light the candle of Peace. Yet true peace begins with conversion—a turning away from whatever hardens the heart and a renewed openness to the transforming grace of God. John the Baptist reminds us that preparing the way of the Lord is an active task. It may mean mending a relationship, making room for prayer, simplifying our lives, or letting go of habits that do not reflect God’s kingdom.

As we continue our Advent journey, let us ask for the grace to hear the voice crying out in our own wilderness. May we respond with courage, humility, and hope, preparing our hearts so that Christ may find in us a place worthy of His peace. Let us not only be ready to receive it, but as well to give it to others. Come, Lord Jesus.

This weekend we celebrate the Blessed Mother venerated in Paraguay under the invocation of Our Lady of Caacupe. May the Immaculate Virgin Mary, Patroness of the Church in the United States of America intercede for the Church in both Americas, so that we may grow in faith, hope and love for God and for others as we nurture the tender care that God has shown for all peoples in the example of the Blessed Mother. May the people of Paraguay and of the Americas be enriched by the devotion and recognition of her Motherly love in the midst of every family. God bless everyone always!

Queridas hermanas y queridos hermanos:

Al entrar en el Segundo Domingo de Adviento, las Escrituras nos invitan a adoptar una actitud más profunda de esperanza y conversión. Hoy encontramos a Juan el Bautista, esa figura valiente e intransigente que clama en el desierto:

“¡Arrepiéntanse, porque el Reino de los Cielos está

ceca!” (Mt 3,2). Su mensaje no pretende infundir miedo, sino

despertar los corazones. El Adviento no se trata simplemente de prepararnos para las festividades navideñas; es un tiempo de preparación espiritual. Cristo viene no solo a Belén, sino a cada corazón dispuesto a recibirlo.

El profeta Isaías ofrece una visión del Mesías distinta de cualquier gobernante terrenal: un brote que surge del tronco de Jesé, lleno del Espíritu de sabiduría, entendimiento, consejo y fortaleza (Is 11,1-10). Este Prometido trae armonía, justicia y paz—tan plenas que incluso los enemigos naturales conviven sin temor. La visión de Isaías nos recuerda que la esperanza de Adviento no es un deseo ingenuo, sino una confianza firme en que Dios actúa, aun cuando el mundo parece un tronco reseco.

San Pablo refuerza esta esperanza animando a la comunidad cristiana a “acogerlos unos a otros como Cristo los acogió a ustedes” (Rom 15,7). La unidad, la paciencia y el consuelo no son virtudes opcionales; son los frutos de un pueblo que sabe que Dios cumple sus promesas.

En esta segunda semana de Adviento encendemos la vela de la Paz. Sin embargo, la verdadera paz comienza con la conversión—con apartarnos de todo aquello que endurece el corazón y con abrirnos nuevamente a la gracia transformadora de Dios. Juan el Bautista nos recuerda que preparar el camino del Señor es una tarea activa. Puede significar reparar una relación, hacer espacio para la oración, simplificar nuestras vidas o abandonar hábitos que no reflejan el Reino de Dios.

A medida que continuamos nuestro camino de Adviento, pidamos la gracia de escuchar la voz que clama en nuestro propio desierto. Que respondamos con valentía, humildad y esperanza, preparando nuestros corazones para que Cristo encuentre en nosotros un lugar digno de su paz. No solo estemos listos para recibirla, sino también para ofrecerla a los demás. Ven, Señor Jesús.

Este fin de semana celebramos a la Santísima Madre venerada en Paraguay bajo la advocación de Nuestra Señora de Caacupé. Que la Virgen Inmaculada, Patrona de la Iglesia en los Estados Unidos de América, interceda por la Iglesia en ambas Américas, para que crezcamos en la fe, la esperanza y el amor a Dios y al prójimo, mientras nos alimentamos del tierno cuidado que Dios ha mostrado a todos los pueblos en el ejemplo de la Santísima Madre. Que el pueblo del Paraguay y de las Américas se enriquezcan con la devoción y el reconocimiento de su amor maternal en medio de cada familia. ¡Que Dios los bendiga siempre!

Deuxième Dimanche de l'Avent(12/07/25)

Le Deuxième Dimanche de l'Avent nous offre deux grandes voix d'espérance :

Isaïe, qui annonce la venue du Messie,

et Jean-Baptiste, qui nous dit comment nous préparer à sa venue.

Isaïe utilise une image frappante :

Un rejeton sortira de la souche de Jessé.

Une souche évoque normalement quelque chose de terminé — coupé, sans vie, sans avenir.

Pourtant, Isaïe affirme que Dieu peut faire naître une vie nouvelle de ce qui semble mort.

C'est cela, l'espérance de l'Avent :

Dieu peut restaurer ce qui est brisé et raviver ce que nous croyions perdu.

Rien n'est trop stérile pour que Dieu y fasse jaillir un commencement nouveau.

Et l'Esprit du Seigneur reposera sur le Messie :

esprit de sagesse, d'intelligence, de conseil, de force, de connaissance et de crainte du Seigneur.

Isaïe décrit un monde transformé :

la paix remplace la violence, l'harmonie remplace la peur, la justice remplace l'oppression.

C'est ce monde que Jésus vient établir — en commençant dans nos cœurs.

Jean-Baptiste apparaît dans le désert comme un prophète d'autrefois et proclame :

« Convertissez-vous, car le Royaume des cieux est tout proche ! »

Son message n'est pas un appel à la peur, mais à la préparation.

Si le Christ vient apporter la paix et le renouveau, notre tâche est de lui faire de la place.

Jean nous rappelle que la foi doit porter du fruit :

« Produisez donc un fruit qui exprime votre conversion », dit-il.

L'Avent est ainsi un temps d'élargissement spirituel :laisser tomber l'amertume choisir le pardon, revenir à la prière, servir ceux qui sont dans le besoin simplifier notre cœur, Isaïe nous apporte l'espérance — Dieu fait du neuf.

Jean nous donne la direction — prépare ton cœur.

L'Avent est les deux à la fois :la promesse de Dieu de nous renouveler notre réponse pour Lui ouvrir la porte
