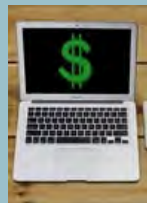

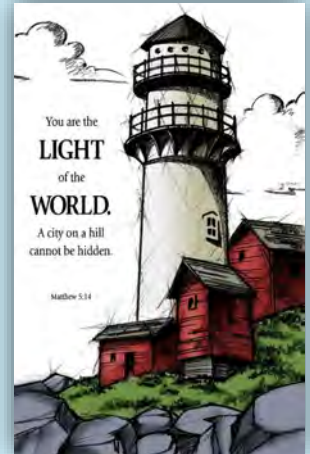

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples, "You are the salt of the earth... You are the light of the world." These are not compliments so much as callings. Salt only matters when it is used, and light only fulfills its purpose when it shines outward. Discipleship, Jesus reminds us, is never meant to be hidden or kept private.



The first reading from Isaiah helps us understand what this looks like in real life. True faith is not only about prayer or ritual, but about concrete acts of love: feeding the hungry, sheltering the oppressed, and caring for those in need. When we live this way, Isaiah says, "your light shall break forth like the dawn." Our faith becomes visible through compassion.

Saint Paul, writing to the Corinthians, echoes this message by reminding them that the power of the Gospel does not come from impressive words or human wisdom, but from the quiet strength of God at work in ordinary people. When we live with humility and trust, God's light shines through us.

As we gather for Eucharist this week, we are reminded that Christ is the true Light who nourishes us. Strengthened by Him, we are sent out to bring flavor to a world that can feel bland and hope to places that feel dark. May we live our faith boldly, so that others, seeing our good works, may give glory to God.

Today's readings speak of the practicalities of the call to be a disciple and put them into words as a parable of salt and other images that in reality become an expression of life. As we buried Ed Ercole this week, looking at his life and his involvement in practical ways of serving others and God, I could see in him the embodiment of those parables and comparisons that the scripture makes. I think of Ed as servant of God, lover of his wife and family, lover of life and dedicated brother to others and even the strangers. All of it lived with the spark of good humor about everything, always positive, always with some good practical advice, ready to help you with anything. You could always count on Ed and his team, Carol and Many. God bless You Ed!!! Thank You for everything!!! You will be greatly missed and never forgotten!!! You were unique!!! Rest in peace Ed!!!

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús dice a sus discípulos: «Ustedes son la sal de la tierra... Ustedes son la luz del mundo». Estas palabras no son tanto un elogio como un llamado. La sal solo importa cuando se usa, y la luz solo cumple su propósito cuando brilla hacia afuera. El discipulado, nos recuerda Jesús, nunca está destinado a esconderse ni a mantenerse en privado.

La primera lectura del profeta Isaías nos ayuda a comprender cómo se vive esto en la vida real. La fe verdadera no se trata solo de la oración o del ritual, sino de actos concretos de amor: alimentar al hambriento, dar refugio al oprimido y cuidar a quienes están en necesidad. Cuando vivimos de esta manera, dice Isaías, «tu luz surgirá como la aurora». Nuestra fe se hace visible a través de la compasión.

San Pablo, al escribir a los corintios, hace eco de este mensaje al recordarles que el poder del Evangelio no proviene de palabras impresionantes ni de la sabiduría humana, sino de la fuerza silenciosa de Dios que actúa en personas ordinarias. Cuando vivimos con humildad y confianza, la luz de Dios brilla a través de nosotros.

Al reunirnos para la Eucaristía esta semana, recordamos que Cristo es la verdadera Luz que nos alimenta. Fortalecidos por Él, somos enviados a dar sabor a un mundo que a veces puede parecer insípido y a llevar esperanza a los lugares que se sienten oscuros. Que vivamos nuestra fe con valentía, para que otros, al ver nuestras buenas obras, den gloria a Dios.

Las lecturas de hoy hablan de la dimensión práctica del llamado a ser discípulos y lo expresan con palabras en forma de parábolas, como la de la sal y otras imágenes que, en la realidad de la vida, se convierten en una expresión viva de la fe. Al sepultar esta semana a Ed Ercole, al contemplar su vida y su compromiso en servir de manera concreta a los demás y a Dios, pude ver en él la encarnación de esas parábolas y comparaciones que nos presenta la Escritura. Pienso en Ed como un siervo de Dios, amante de su esposa y de su familia, amante de la vida y hermano dedicado a los demás, incluso a los desconocidos. Todo esto vivido con una chispa de buen humor ante todo, siempre positivo, siempre con algún buen consejo práctico, dispuesto a ayudarte en lo que fuera. Siempre se podía contar con Ed y su equipo, Carol y Many. ¡Dios te bendiga, Ed! ¡Gracias por todo! ¡Te vamos a extrañar muchísimo y nunca serás olvidado! ¡Fuiste único! Descansa en paz, Ed.

Matthieu 5, 13-16

Cinquième dimanche du Temps ordinaire (02/08/2026)

Les lectures d'aujourd'hui tournent toutes autour d'une question essentielle : à quoi ressemble une foi authentique lorsqu'elle est vécue concrètement ?

Dans l'Évangile, Jésus nous dit : « Vous êtes le sel de la terre... Vous êtes la lumière du monde. » Remarquons-le bien : il ne dit pas vous devriez être le sel et la lumière. Il dit vous êtes. C'est notre identité de disciples. Le sel n'existe pas pour lui-même ; il donne du goût et il préserve la vie. La lumière n'attire pas l'attention sur elle-même ; elle permet aux autres de voir. De la même manière, notre foi est faite pour être vécue au service des autres.



Le prophète Isaïe rend cela très concret. Le véritable culte rendu à Dieu ne se limite pas à la prière ou aux sacrifices, mais consiste à partager son pain avec l'affamé, à accueillir les opprimés, à prendre soin de ceux qui sont dans le besoin. Alors, dit Isaïe, « ta lumière jaillira comme l'aurore ». Autrement dit, l'amour mis en actes rend Dieu visible.

Saint Paul, dans la deuxième lecture, nous rappelle que cette force ne vient ni de l'éloquence, ni du prestige, ni de la sagesse humaine. Il se présente aux Corinthiens dans la faiblesse et l'humilité, afin que leur foi ne repose pas sur les hommes, mais sur la puissance de Dieu. La lumière que nous faisons briller n'est pas la nôtre : c'est la grâce de Dieu à l'œuvre en nous.

Ainsi, le message d'aujourd'hui est simple mais exigeant : le monde connaîtra Dieu non pas par la beauté de nos paroles, mais par la qualité de notre amour. Chaque petit geste de bonté, d'honnêteté, de miséricorde et de compassion devient une lampe placée sur le lampadaire.

En avançant dans cette semaine, demandons la grâce de vivre ce que nous croyons : d'être un sel qui apporte guérison et une lumière qui conduit les autres vers Dieu, afin que, comme le dit Jésus, « ils voient vos bonnes œuvres et rendent gloire à votre Père qui est aux cieux ».
