Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As we approach the final days of Lent, the readings for the Fifth Sunday lead us into one of the most powerful moments in the Gospel: the raising of Lazarus (John 11:1–45).

This remarkable story reveals not only the power of Jesus over death, but also the depth of His compassion and the promise of new life for all who believe in Him. When Jesus arrives in Bethany, Lazarus has already been in the tomb for four days. Martha and Mary are grieving, and many others have come to comfort them. In the midst of this sorrow, Martha expresses both faith and hope when she says to Jesus, “Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died.” Jesus responds with one of the most profound declarations in the Gospel: “I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live.”


Before performing the miracle, Jesus weeps. These simple words—“Jesus wept”—reveal the heart of our Savior. He is not distant from human suffering; He enters into it. He shares the pain of loss and stands beside those who mourn. At the same time, He shows that death does not have the final word. Standing before the tomb, Jesus calls out, “Lazarus, come out!” And the man who had been dead walks out alive. This miracle is a sign pointing toward the greater victory that will soon come through Christ’s own death and resurrection.

Yet this Gospel is not only about Lazarus. It also speaks to our own lives. Sometimes we experience forms of spiritual death—moments when discouragement, sin, or despair leave us feeling trapped in darkness. Like Lazarus in the tomb, we may feel bound by the things that hold us back. But the voice of Christ still calls to us. He calls us out of whatever binds us and invites us into new life. Through His mercy, especially in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, the Lord frees us and restores us. As St. Augustine reflected on this Gospel: “Lazarus, come forth! The Lord called the dead man, and the one who had lost life returned to life.”


As we enter the final stretch of Lent and prepare for Holy Week, this Gospel invites us to renew our faith in Christ, who is truly the resurrection and the life. He calls each of us by name, just as He called Lazarus, and invites us to step out of darkness into His light. As St. Gregory the Great teaches: “The voice of the Lord cried out to the dead, and the one who was bound in the darkness of the tomb came forth into the light.” Let us listen for His voice, trust in His promise, and walk forward in the new life He offers.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:



Al acercarnos a los últimos días de la Cuaresma, las lecturas del Quinto Domingo nos conducen a uno de los momentos más poderosos del Evangelio: la resurrección de Lázaro (Juan 11,1–45). Esta notable historia revela no solo el poder de Jesús sobre la muerte, sino también la profundidad de su compasión y la promesa de una vida nueva para todos los que creen en Él. Cuando Jesús llega a Betania, Lázaro ya llevaba cuatro días en el sepulcro. Marta y María están de luto, y muchos otros han venido a consolarlas. En medio de este dolor, Marta expresa tanto fe como esperanza cuando le dice a Jesús: “Señor, si hubieras estado aquí, mi hermano no habría muerto.” Jesús responde con una de las declaraciones más profundas del Evangelio: “Yo soy la resurrección y la vida; el que cree en mí, aunque muera, vivirá.”

Antes de realizar el milagro, Jesús llora. Estas simples palabras—“Jesús lloró”—revelan el corazón de nuestro Salvador. Él no está distante del sufrimiento humano; entra en él. Comparte el dolor de la pérdida y permanece al lado de quienes lloran. Al mismo tiempo, muestra que la muerte no tiene la última palabra. De pie frente al sepulcro, Jesús clama: “¡Lázaro, sal fuera!” Y el hombre que había estado muerto sale vivo. Este milagro es una señal que apunta hacia la victoria aún mayor que pronto llegará por medio de la propia muerte y resurrección de Cristo.

Sin embargo, este Evangelio no trata solamente de Lázaro. También habla de nuestras propias vidas. A veces experimentamos formas de muerte espiritual—momentos en los que el desánimo, el pecado o la desesperación nos dejan atrapados en la oscuridad. Como Lázaro en el sepulcro, podemos sentirnos atados por aquello que nos detiene. Pero la voz de Cristo todavía nos llama. Nos llama a salir de aquello que nos ata y nos invita a una vida nueva. Por su misericordia, especialmente en el Sacramento de la Reconciliación, el Señor nos libera y nos restaura. Como reflexionó San Agustín sobre este Evangelio: “¡Lázaro, ven afuera! El Señor llamó al hombre muerto, y el que había perdido la vida volvió a la vida.”

Al entrar en la etapa final de la Cuaresma y prepararnos para la Semana Santa, este Evangelio nos invita a renovar nuestra fe en Cristo, quien verdaderamente es la resurrección y la vida. Él nos llama a cada uno por nuestro nombre, así como llamó a Lázaro, y nos invita a salir de la oscuridad hacia su luz. Como enseña San Gregorio Magno: “La voz del Señor clamó a los muertos, y aquel que estaba atado en la oscuridad del sepulcro salió a la luz.” Escuchemos su voz, confiemos en su promesa y caminemos hacia adelante en la vida nueva que Él nos ofrece.

¡Que Dios bendiga siempre a todos!

Cinquième Dimanche de Carême (03/22/2026)

Chers frères et sœurs,

En ce cinquième dimanche de Carême, la liturgie nous parle de vie... au cœur même de la mort.

Dans le livre du prophète Livre d'Ézéchiel (37, 12-14), Dieu promet : « Je vais ouvrir vos tombeaux et je vous en ferai remonter. » Cette parole était d'abord une espérance pour un peuple en exil, découragé, comme mort intérieurement. Mais elle annonce déjà quelque chose de plus grand : Dieu n'abandonne jamais son peuple à la mort.

Saint Paul, dans la Lettre aux Romains (8, 8-11), nous rappelle que l'Esprit de Dieu habite en nous. Cet Esprit est source de vie. Même si notre corps est marqué par la fragilité, l'Esprit nous fait déjà participer à la vie nouvelle.


Et dans l'Évangile selon Évangile selon saint Jean (11, 1-45), nous contemplons la résurrection de Lazare. Devant le tombeau de son ami, Jésus pleure. Il partage notre douleur, notre deuil, nos larmes. Puis il crie : « Lazare, viens dehors ! » Et le mort sort du tombeau.

Ce signe annonce la victoire définitive du Christ sur la mort. Mais il nous parle aussi de nos propres tombeaux : le péché, le découragement, la peur, le manque d'espérance. Il y a parfois en nous des zones fermées, liées, comme Lazare avec ses bandelettes.

Le Carême touche à sa fin. Bientôt nous entrerons dans la Semaine Sainte. Aujourd'hui, le Seigneur nous appelle déjà à sortir de nos tombeaux. Il nous dit : laisse-moi entrer dans tes ténèbres, laisse-moi t'appeler à la vie.

Croyons-nous vraiment qu'il est « la Résurrection et la Vie » ? Si nous ouvrons notre cœur, son Esprit peut déjà nous relever, nous libérer, nous redonner souffle et espérance.

Que ce dimanche ravive en nous la foi en la puissance de Dieu, plus forte que toute mort. Amen.


