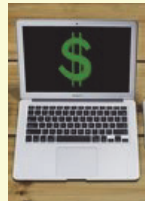

## Message from the Our Pastor – The Most Holy Trinity Sunday

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Today the Church celebrates one of the greatest mysteries of our faith: the Holy Trinity — one God in three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. While the Trinity can seem difficult to explain, it is not meant to be merely a puzzle to solve. It is a mystery to enter and to live. In today's Gospel, Jesus sends His disciples into the world with these words: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations... baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Through Baptism, each of us has been drawn into the very life and love of God.



The Trinity teaches us that God is not solitary or distant. God is relationship. From all eternity, the Father pours out love to the Son; the Son receives and returns that love completely; and the Holy Spirit is the bond of love shared between them. We are created in the image of this God of communion and love. This has practical meaning for our lives. If we are made in God's image, then we are made for relationships — with God and with one another. We grow in holiness not by isolation, but by learning to love generously, forgive sincerely, serve humbly, and live as people united in Christ.

Every time we make the Sign of the Cross, we proclaim this mystery: "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." We do it so often that we may forget its significance. Yet in that simple prayer we place ourselves in the presence of the God who created us, redeemed us, and continues to sanctify us.

As we celebrate Trinity Sunday, perhaps our task is not to fully understand the mystery of God, but to allow ourselves to be transformed by it. May our families, our parish, and our community become reflections of the love and unity that exist in the heart of the Trinity. Holy Trinity, one God, help us to live in your love and share that love with others.

Estimados Hermanos y Hermanas:

Hoy la Iglesia celebra uno de los más grandes misterios de nuestra fe: la Santísima Trinidad — un solo Dios en tres Personas: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Aunque la Trinidad puede parecer difícil de explicar, no está destinada a ser simplemente un rompecabezas para resolver. Es un misterio en el cual debemos entrar y vivir. En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús envía a sus discípulos al mundo con estas palabras: “Vayan, pues, y hagan discípulos a todas las naciones... bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo.” A través del Bautismo, cada uno de nosotros ha sido introducido en la misma vida y amor de Dios.



La Trinidad nos enseña que Dios no es solitario ni distante. Dios es relación. Desde toda la eternidad, el Padre derrama su amor sobre el Hijo; el Hijo recibe y devuelve ese amor plenamente; y el Espíritu Santo es el vínculo de amor compartido entre ambos. Hemos sido creados a imagen de este Dios de comunión y amor. Esto tiene un significado práctico para nuestras vidas. Si hemos sido creados a imagen de Dios, entonces hemos sido creados para las relaciones: con Dios y con los demás. Creemos en santidad no mediante el aislamiento, sino aprendiendo a amar generosamente, perdonar sinceramente, servir humildemente y vivir como personas unidas en Cristo.

Cada vez que hacemos la Señal de la Cruz, proclamamos este misterio: “En el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo.” Lo hacemos tan frecuentemente que podemos olvidar su significado. Sin embargo, en esa sencilla oración nos colocamos en la presencia del Dios que nos creó, nos redimió y continúa santificándonos.

Mientras celebramos el Domingo de la Santísima Trinidad, quizás nuestra tarea no sea comprender plenamente el misterio de Dios, sino permitir que ese misterio nos transforme. Que nuestras familias, nuestra parroquia y nuestra comunidad se conviertan en reflejos del amor y la unidad que existen en el corazón de la Trinidad. Santísima Trinidad, un solo Dios, ayúdanos a vivir en tu amor y a compartir ese amor con los demás.

Que Dios bendiga siempre a todos!!!

Frères et sœurs,

Aujourd'hui, l'Église célèbre le mystère de la Très Sainte Trinité : un seul Dieu en trois Personnes — le Père, le Fils et le Saint-Esprit. Ce mystère n'est pas une théorie compliquée, mais une révélation de l'amour de Dieu.

Dans la première lecture, Dieu se révèle à Moïse comme un Dieu « tendre et miséricordieux, lent à la colère et plein d'amour et de vérité ». Voilà le visage du Père : un Dieu proche de son peuple, patient et fidèle.

Dans l'Évangile, Jésus nous montre jusqu'où va cet amour : « Dieu a tant aimé le monde qu'il a donné son Fils unique. » Le Fils n'est pas venu pour condamner, mais pour sauver. La Trinité est donc un mouvement d'amour qui se donne entièrement pour l'humanité.

Enfin, saint Paul nous rappelle que l'Esprit Saint agit au milieu de nous lorsque nous vivons dans la paix, la joie et la communion : « La grâce du Seigneur Jésus Christ, l'amour de Dieu et la communion du Saint-Esprit soient avec vous tous. »

La Trinité nous enseigne alors une manière de vivre : aimer comme le Père, servir comme le Fils, et construire l'unité par l'Esprit Saint.

En faisant le signe de la croix, rappelons-nous que nous sommes plongés dans cet amour trinitaire chaque jour de notre vie.

Amen.

**PILGRIMAGE TO FATIMA,  
LOURDES AND SPAIN

**Day 3 Wed. Sept. 30<sup>th</sup> Lisbon-Santarem-Fatima**

In the morning, we will departure towards Fatima. On the way we will stop in the old city of Santarem. In Santarem we will visit and attend Mass at the Church of St. Stephen, which holds the oldest (13th century) recorded Eucharistic Miracle in Portugal. The Miracle occurred when a woman yearned to change the ways of her unfaithful husband and consulted a sorceress. The sorceress agreed that she would cure the husband's infidelity in exchange for a consecrated Host. The woman committed the sacrilege, but when she exited the church, the Host began to bleed. It bled so much that her fellow parishioners thought she had cut her hand. The woman ran home and hid the bleeding Host in a trunk. When her husband arrived home, the wife told him what she had done, and later that night there was a light emanating from the trunk. She and her husband began to kneel before the trunk. The following morning, the husband and wife brought the Host to the parish priest. It was then moved to the Church of St. Stephen where another miracle occurred; the miraculous Host was originally put in a wax container, however, when a priest opened the tabernacle to view the Host, the container was found broken, and the Host was found enclosed in a crystal pyx. Continuation of the journey to Fatima. In the afternoon we will start the visit of the most important places related to the apparitions located in the surroundings of Fatima: Parish Church of Fatima, the Cemetery of Fatima (Where we will find the tomb where Saint Francesco and Saint Jacinta were buried after they passed away) and Aljustrel (The hamlet of the three children). In Aljustrel we will visit the houses where the three children lived and also the well where the Angel of Peace appeared in Summer 1916 (second apparition of the Angel). Dinner in the hotel. After dinner we will be able to gather with the rest of the pilgrims in Fatima at the Chapel of the Apparitions, where Our Blessed Mother appeared, to pray the Rosary and to participate in the candlelight procession. Overnight in Fatima.
