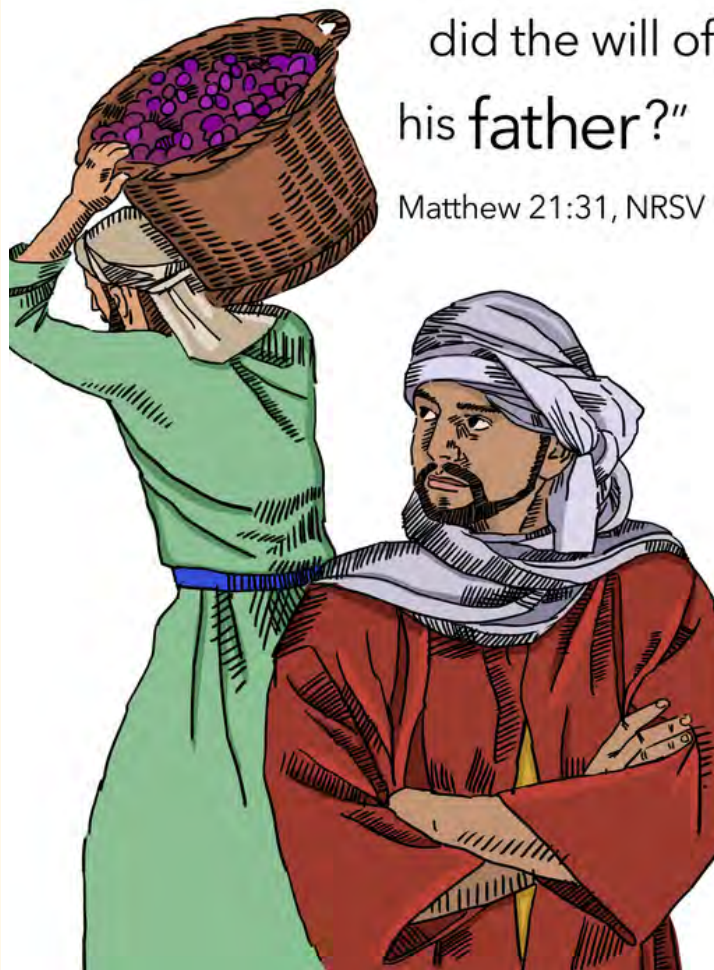

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This Sunday's Gospel (Matthew 21:28-32) presents a simple yet piercing parable about obedience. A father asks his two sons to work in the vineyard. The first refuses bluntly—"I will not"—but later changes his mind and goes. The second answers politely—"Yes, sir"—yet never shows up. Jesus asks the religious leaders: which son did the father's will? They correctly answer, "The first." Jesus then turns the parable on them. Tax collectors and prostitutes—people who initially said "no" to God through their lives—heard John the Baptist's call, repented, and entered the kingdom ahead of those who claimed faithfulness to God, but resisted conversion to follow Jesus.

The first reading from Ezekiel (18:25-28) echoes the same truth. God's ways are not unfair. A virtuous person who turns to sin faces the consequences of that choice. But a sinner who turns from wickedness and does what is right and just "shall surely live." God judges not by past reputation or empty promises, but by the present direction of the heart and the concrete actions that follow.

St. Paul, in the second reading (Philippians 2:1-11), shows us the perfect model of this obedience. Jesus "emptied himself... becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross." His "yes" was not mere words; it was lived out completely. Because of that total self-giving, God highly exalted him.

These readings invite honest self-examination. Do we sometimes resemble the second son—quick with religious language, regular in practice, yet slow to act when the vineyard demands real sacrifice, forgiveness, generosity, or change? Or do we, like the first son, recognize our refusals and allow God's mercy to turn us around? The good news is that God never closes the door on a change of heart. Today's psalm prays, "Remember your mercies, O Lord." Those mercies are always available. Conversion is possible at any moment. What matters is that we eventually go into the vineyard and do the work.

This week, let us ask for the grace of genuine repentance—not just regret, but a decisive turning that shows itself in action. May we grow in the humility of Christ, who said "yes" with his whole life, and may our words and deeds become one. Lord, teach us your ways. Help us to move beyond empty promises and live in obedience to you that will lead us to eternal life. God bless everyone always!!!

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

En el Evangelio de este domingo (Mateo 21,28-32) se nos presenta una parábola sencilla pero penetrante sobre la obediencia. Un padre pide a sus dos hijos que vayan a trabajar en la viña. El primero se niega de manera rotunda: «No quiero», pero más tarde se arrepiente y va. El segundo responde cortésmente: «Sí, señor», pero nunca se presenta. Jesús pregunta a los jefes religiosos: ¿Cuál de los dos hizo la voluntad del padre? Ellos responden correctamente: «El primero».

Entonces Jesús aplica la parábola a ellos. Los publicanos y las prostitutas —personas que inicialmente dijeron «no» a Dios con su forma de vivir— escucharon la llamada de Juan el Bautista, se arrepintieron y entraron en el Reino por delante de aquellos que afirmaban ser fieles a Dios, pero se resistían a la conversión para seguir a Jesús.

La primera lectura del profeta Ezequiel (18,25-28) repite la misma verdad. Los caminos de Dios no son injustos. Una persona virtuosa que se aparta de la virtud y comete el mal enfrenta las consecuencias de esa elección. Pero el pecador que se aparta de su maldad y practica el derecho y la justicia «ciertamente vivirá». Dios no juzga por la reputación del pasado ni por promesas vacías, sino por la dirección actual del corazón y las acciones concretas que de él se derivan.

San Pablo, en la segunda lectura (Filipenses 2,1-11), nos muestra el modelo perfecto de esta obediencia. Jesús «se despojó de sí mismo... haciéndose obediente hasta la muerte, y una muerte de cruz». Su «sí» no fueron meras palabras; lo vivió plenamente. Por esa entrega total, Dios lo exaltó sobremanera.

Estas lecturas nos invitan a un examen de conciencia sincero. ¿Nos parecemos a veces al segundo hijo: rápidos en el lenguaje religioso, regulares en la práctica, pero lentos a la hora de actuar cuando la viña exige verdadero sacrificio, perdón, generosidad o cambio? ¿O reconocemos, como el primer hijo, nuestras negativas y permitimos que la misericordia de Dios nos transforme? La buena noticia es que Dios nunca cierra la puerta a un cambio de corazón. El salmo de hoy reza: «Acuérdate, Señor, de tu misericordia». Esa misericordia está siempre disponible. La conversión es posible en cualquier momento. Lo que importa es que al final vayamos a la viña y hagamos el trabajo.

Esta semana pidamos la gracia de un arrepentimiento genuino: no solo un remordimiento, sino un giro decisivo que se manifieste en obras. Que crezcamos en la humildad de Cristo, que dijo «sí» con toda su vida, y que nuestras palabras y nuestras acciones sean una sola cosa. Señor, enséñanos tus caminos. Ayúdanos a superar las promesas vacías y a vivir en obediencia a ti, que nos conduce a la vida eterna.

¡Que Dios bendiga a todos siempre!

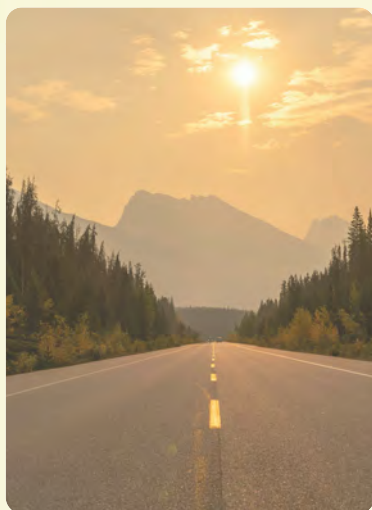

Aujourd'hui, nous vivons dans une époque où de nouvelles maladies mentales atteignent une portée insoupçonnée, comme jamais on ne l'avait vu dans le cours de l'histoire. Cette solitude à laquelle nous sommes obligés, par convenances sociales, par la pression au travail, par certaines conventions qui rendent esclaves, font que plusieurs tombent dans la dépression, la névrose, l'hystérie, la schizophrénie ou autres déséquilibres qui marquent profondément le futur de ces personnes.

« Jésus, ayant rassemblé les douze, leur donna force et pouvoir sur tous les démons, avec la puissance de guérir les maladies » (Lc 9,1). Ce sont ces maux, que nous pouvons identifier dans l'Évangile comme des maladies mentales.

La rencontre avec le Christ, personne accomplie et complète, apporte équilibre et paix, capables d'apaiser l'âme et de ramener l'homme à lui-même, apportant clarté et lumière à sa vie et à son avenir. L'Évangile est

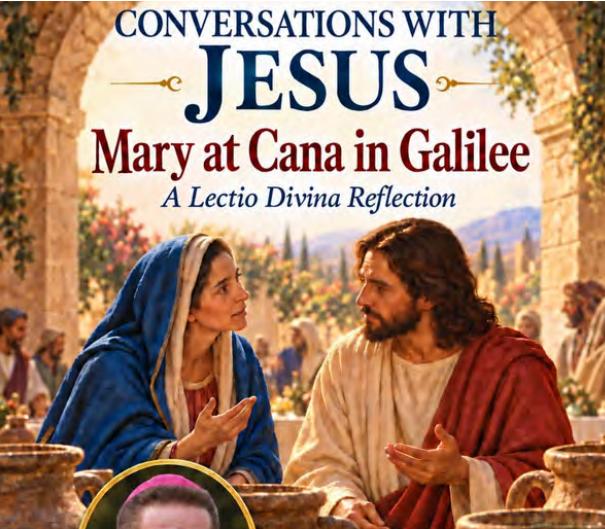
